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Carroll ISD Once Again Exceeds Performance Metrics In Newest Districtwide Report Card

CISD Scores Top Acclaim in TEA and STAAR Reports as well as Top Graduation Rates, Math, Reading, ACT and SAT Scores, and more

Districtwide, CISD and all 11 campuses scored an “A” grade from the Texas Education Agency

Southlake, Texas — Carroll ISD can announce once again that the school district excelled across all categories of metrics in the latest Texas Education Agency (TEA) STAAR Accountability Ratings, as well as CISD’s own Community-Based Report Card which measures metrics against the district’s strategic plan.

The district earned an “A” grade overall from TEA, as well as an “A” grade for every school campus throughout the district. CISD also ranked higher than statewide averages in STAAR ratings for achievement in all tested subjects, including exceeding Masters level of achievement across math and reading for all grade levels tested. CISD’s Community-Based Report Card — which measures performance across several categories including ACT and SAT scores, post-secondary acceptances, scholarship dollars earned, extra-curricular championships, community service and more — once again shows CISD dominates state and national averages.

Carroll ISD excelled in the following areas:

- ACT Scores – an average of 27.2 (compared to the national average of 20.3)
- SAT Scores – an average of 1265 (compared to the national average of 1060)
- Graduation Rate to College — 99%
- College Scholarship Money Earned: \$32 Million
- National Merit Program: 14 finalists
- Percentage of Students Attending 2- or 4-Year Colleges/Universities: 99%
- Hours of College Credits Earned: 10,318

- Community Service Hours Donated: 54,680
- Award Winners of the Prestigious UIL Lone Star Cup Award
 - Champions with the most points ever
 - 7 State Championships
 - 11 District Championship
 - 8x Lone Star Cup Champions

In addition, CISD exceeded the statewide average in STAAR rankings, across all grades:

- STAAR Masters Level Achievement in Math:
 - District 72% - (compared to 31% statewide)
- STAAR Masters Level Achievement in Reading:
 - District 63% - (compared to 17.5% statewide)

The strong accountability ratings once again demonstrate CISD's commitment to *"Inspire Excellence"* and the Dragon core values of excellence; integrity and character; respectful relationships; curiosity and innovation; honest communication; and service.

The district is also focused on student and school safety initiatives, including physical security at all campuses within CISD and protection against bullying, harrassment, and discrimination, as defined in school policy. Currently, every campus within the school district is staffed with at least one school resource officer, with plans announced recently by the City of Southlake to add additional officers.

As Carroll ISD Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Lane Ledbetter, recently shared at the 2022-2023 Back-to-School Convocation, the district has no plans for slowing down.

"We are so pleased that Carroll ISD has had another banner year in education, community service, preparation for higher education, and great extracurricular performance," said Superintendent Lane Ledbetter. "As we look forward to the school year 2022-2023 focused on our strategic vision, I am confident that our teachers, staff, and administrators are united behind one thing: Inspiring Excellence. We will work together, once again, to exceed expectations on accountability metrics and it is our mission to educate and inspire every Dragon through a tradition of excellence and innovation in academics, character, and service for lifelong success."
