

Because Tennessee is an ACT-dominant state, the majority of our seniors choose not to take the SAT. For this reason, we include ACT data only to give the most accurate view of the entire class.



Transportation

Our students come from over 162 feeder schools in Middle Tennessee and Kentucky. Pope Prep provides six bus routes, including as far as Bowling Green, Kentucky, to accommodate the needs of our students, and to ensure that transportation is not a barrier for those who wish to attend. Our bus system also allows those without transportation to participate in after school activities.

Post-Secondary Plans

The 135 graduates of the Class of 2022 were accepted to 129 different colleges. They enrolled in 56 different colleges in 24 states and 2 countries. They earned a collective \$13,367,608 in scholarship. Fifty-Five percent of students will be attending an in-state institution and 45% will be attending an out of state institution.

Hand in Hand Options

The Hand in Hand program provides students with intellectual and developmental disabilities the opportunity for full inclusion and a Catholic education. Pope Prep students have the option to serve as trained mentors to provide support, assist teachers, and work with their Hand in Hand mentor to build a relationship around friendly learning.

Internships

Students who are interested in gaining real world experience can apply to complete an internship. This program requires an additional commitment outside of the school day. Students work to develop their interests and job skills.

Knights Success Program

The Knights Success Program coordinates academic support and accommodations. Through the course students learn accountability, create strategies to succeed, and learn to recognize their individual learning style.

House System

The Pope Prep House System consists of six different houses - Clement, Gregory, John, Leo, Peter, and Pius. Students are assigned to a house upon enrollment and remain in that house through graduation. The House System creates smaller communities within the school to encourage friendship, promote school spirit, and develop student leadership. The student-led House Council works with faculty to plan social events, school spirit days, and acts as a form of student government.
