Each school year, Bishop Shanahan High School celebrates the time-honored tradition of Baccalaureate Mass with the graduating class of seniors. It is a beautiful ceremony in which families, future alumni, faculty, and staff can come together in prayer and thanksgiving for all of the Lord's blessings. As Baccalaureate Mass takes place the evening before the graduation ceremony, it

also serves as a special way for the Shanahan community to pay tribute to all that the seniors have accomplished during their four year high school career. Scholarship: The Tax Credit Program

The BSHS Tax Credit program has helped a tremendous number of students since its first year in 2001. For the current school year, Bishop Shanahan was able to award \$549,483 to students in need. This vital funding has enabled 154 families to afford a Bishop Shanahan education

Shanahan would be a very different school without each of these students. These young men and women make an impact in the classroom, on the playing fields, on the stage, and are active

members of the Shanahan faith community.

Bishop Shanahan is extremely grateful to the 71 individuals and local businesses who redirected a portion of their Pennsylvania tax liability in 2021, ranging from \$450 to \$50,000! Every dollar was put toward the tuition of Shanahan students.

Shanahan Welcomes Father John Donia as its New President

Excerpts from Catholic Philly "Bishop Shanahan Appoints Familiar Priest as New President"

Bishop Shanahan High School welcomes Father John Donia as its third president, beginning in the 2022-2023 school year.

A Philadelphia priest with “an enthusiastic commitment to Catholic education” has been selected to head up Bishop Shanahan High School in Downingtown, said archdiocesan officials.

Nancy Kurtz, interim superintendent of secondary schools, and Jay DeFruscio, chief operating officer, described Father Donia as “an integral part of the Bishop Shanahan community.”

Father Donia served as the school’s School Minister from 2015-2021, and then as the School Principal from 2021-2022.

“He truly embodies the school’s mission of nurturing young adults to be ‘People of God; People for Others,’” shared the Office of Catholic Education, quoting the school’s guiding principle.

In addition, Father Donia “has demonstrated his commitment to Bishop Shanahan’s academic excellence and global solidarity,” said archdiocesan officials in their letter to the school community.

Previously, he served as a school minister and theology instructor at Archbishop Ryan High School, and as an adjunct professor in La Salle University’s bilingual undergraduate studies program.

Ordained in 2007, Father Donia holds several degrees from St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, including a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy, a Master of Divinity and a Master of Arts in Theology.

A Maguire Fellow, Father Donia completed his Master of Science degree in Educational Leadership at St. Joseph’s University, obtaining his principal’s certification in 2018. His previous pastoral appointments include parochial vicar of St.

Timothy Parish and parochial administrator at Holy Name of Jesus, both in Philadelphia.

Given his education and experience, Father Donia is “well prepared to lead Bishop

Shanahan administrators, faculty, staff and school families as they write they next chapter of the school’s history,” said OCE administrators.

Celebrating 22 Years of Faithful Service

After 22 years of faithful service at Bishop Shanahan High School, Sister Regina Plunkett IHM '64 offered her resignation as the President in March of 2022.

After attending BSHS from 1960 to 1964, Sister Regina entered the Congregation of the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in 1964, professing her First Vows in 1967. Sister then served as a teacher in the Philadelphia area, Peru, and Chile. In 2000 she began at Shanahan as the Administrative Assistant in the Office of Academic Affairs and then became President in 2002 through 2022. When she was appointed as president, in her first letter to the Shanahan community, she introduced the spiritual theme for the year, "People of God; People for Others," which has since become the school's guiding principle.

During her tenure as president, Sister's efforts and initiatives have become the cornerstone of Shanahan's academic excellence, robust student life, and community of faith.

In 2003, Sister Regina recognized the importance of embracing the legacy of BSHS from its roots as Saint Agnes High School. To honor this history, she began the Saint Agnes Alumni Reunion, a special reception held each May to strengthen the relationship between the two schools.

"Forever Green, Forever Growing," a \$1.4 capital campaign to support technology, fine arts, professional development, tuition assistance, and enhancements to the stadium was launched in 2004.

In 2006, the inaugural Bishop Shanahan Endowment Fund Golf Outing kicked off. This event was designed to generate philanthropic support for BSHS as well as strengthen the relationship between BSHS and prospective individual donors and businesses.

BSHS hosted a Gala in honor of the 50th Anniversary in 2008. The Class of 1958 was honored during the 2008 Commencement Ceremony and this began the tradition of the Golden Eagle Reception immediately following graduation.



In 2012, as a result of the Global Awareness Program, Shanahan was recognized as a "Platinum School" by Catholic Relief Services, one of only 23 schools across the nation to achieve this level.

BSHS launched a \$2 million campaign, "Our Team, Our Dream," in 2014 to add a turf field and lights, as well as an updated track.

In 2015, Pope Francis visited Philadelphia for the World Meeting of Families. The Bishop Shanahan Marching Band was invited to perform at the airport to welcome the Holy Father. In Spanish, Sister Regina asked Pope Francis, "Santo Padre, bendícenos, por favor" (Holy Father, please bless us.)

In recognition of Bishop Shanahan's 60th anniversary in 2017, Sister Regina beautified the campus with new flag poles, a new

sign at the entrance to the school, and a memorial garden dedicated to Sister Helen Rapine IHM (former BSHS principal and its first president). That year, the school also dedicated a new state-of-the-art sound system in the auditorium, made possible by the *Nick Smiles on the Fine Arts Foundation* and Nick Mullin's '08 parents, Tom and Dee Mullin.

Sister Regina welcomed back to Bishop Shanahan many Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary as recipients of the 2019 Shanahan Medal. Meanwhile, Shanahan was also recognized as a leading school by the Middle States Association by adhering to the "Sustaining Excellence" protocol.

Under Sister Regina's leadership, Shanahan reimagined education and successfully adapted to a hybrid learning environment from 2020 to 2021. Shanahan students were able to thrive in academics, athletics, fine arts and have an active faith life.

From 2021 to 2022, Shanahan returned to a fully in-person, five days a week schedule full of Shanahan events and traditions.

Bishop Shanahan High School is grateful to Sister Regina for her years of service. She embodies the guiding principle, "People of God; People for Others." God bless Sister Regina in her future missions!

REMEMBERING Sister Maureen McDermott IHM

The Bishop Shanahan High School community mourned the loss of Sister Maureen McDermott, IHM, Chief Academic Officer and Superintendent of Secondary Schools for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, who passed away on November 17, 2021.

Sister Maureen had served as principal of BSHS for 14 years, from 2001 to 2015. She dedicated her life to Catholic education, and in particular to the spiritual formation and personal development of all students. Sister Maureen “loved high school teenagers” and had a particular love for Bishop Shanahan and its students, said Bishop Fitzgerald. “She was totally devoted to them.”

She was a graduate of St. Gabriel School in South Philadelphia where she first encountered the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. She went on to Archbishop Prendergast High School for Girls in Drexel Hill, then graduated from Immaculata University in 1978 with a bachelor’s degree in English.

A year later she entered the I.H.M. order, and after professing her vows, engaged in the order’s charism for Catholic education. She first taught in elementary school classrooms beginning in 1982 then in Catholic secondary schools.

Along the way she earned a master’s degree in English from West Chester University and a Ph.D. in Catholic educational leadership from Fordham University.

In 2001 she was named principal of Bishop Shanahan High School where she served for 14 years until rising to lead the entire Catholic secondary school system as superintendent in 2015.

After that she had overseen a high school system that has invited broad collaboration through the efforts of Faith in the Future Foundation, stabilized the rate of school enrollment decline, grown partnerships with Catholic colleges, faced the challenges of two high school closures, and the immense difficulties with continuing Catholic education during the disruptions of the COVID-19

pandemic.

Sister Maureen was honored posthumously at the Philadelphia St. Patrick’s Day Parade on Sunday, March 13 as part of the St. Patrick’s Ring of Honor. The Ring of Honor recognizes those who have given exemplary service in and to the Irish Community of the Philadelphia Tri-State Area. Prior to the parade the Bishop Shanahan Liturgical

Ensemble joined with the Philadelphia Emerald Society Pipe Band to provide the music at Mass held at Saint Patrick Church.

Bishop Shanahan High School’s thoughts and prayers continue to be with Sister Maureen’s family, IHM Congregation, friends, colleagues, and students. She will be deeply missed and forever remembered in the Shanahan community.

Shanahan Welcomes Newest Alumni, the Class of 2022!



Bishop Shanahan High School held its commencement exercises on Friday, June 10th at 10:00 AM in the BSHS auditorium, paying tribute to the Class of 2022. This year's graduating class included 252 students, all of whom were accepted to four-year colleges including Brown University, Colgate University, the University of Notre Dame, and the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. The class received more than \$49,000,000 in total college scholarships, of which 34 were full tuition scholarships, and 96 were presidential scholarships. The Most Reverend Michael J. Fitzgerald, the Auxiliary Bishop of Philadelphia Overseeing Catholic Education, presided over the graduation ceremony.

Julia Vito, who attends the Villanova University Honors College, was the valedictorian. Megan Bradley, who attends Purdue University, was the salutatorian. During her speech, Julia reflected on the shared experience of her classmates: "Shanahan has led each of us to distinct accomplishments as athletes, musicians, artists, and scholars. Although we're called to different paths, we are united as people for others and children of God."

During the commencement exercises, the Shanahan Medal was posthumously awarded to former Bishop Shanahan Principal, Sister Maureen McDermott IHM. Most recently, Sister Maureen was the Chief Academic Officer and Superintendent of Secondary Schools for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The medal

was accepted on her behalf by Sister Mary Ellen Tennity IHM, General Superior, in the company of five additional members of the IHM Administration. This medal is awarded

annually to a person or group of persons whose service, commitment, and dedication to Catholic education deserve the recognition and gratitude of the Shanahan Community.

STEM Team Wins PA Governor's Competition

The STEM Team swept away the competition with the creation of CASS: Computerized Autonomous Suppressant System. CASS can be used to replace existing means of fire suppression, which typically cause more damage than the fire itself, through the utilization of a safe, chemical powder suppressant.

The team claimed victory as the Grand Champions of the PA Governor's STEM Regional Competition. This annual STEM competition challenges teams to answer needs of Pennsylvanians, while also exploring STEM careers and developing communication, problem-solving, critical thinking, and creativity skills. This year's theme was "Improving Pennsylvania Through STEM." The official BSHS presentation team was comprised of a group of

seniors: Brendan Pappas, James Spaulding, Evelyn Snyder, Gabriel Nichols, and Catherine Flick, and faculty advisor John P. Janasik, PhD.

The team went on to visit the State Capitol in Harrisburg to receive their medals and citations for winning the Governor's STEM Competition. An official citation was read aloud, and members of the team were recognized on the floor of the House of Representatives. The team received a guided tour of the Capitol complex and met with State Representative Dan Williams and Pennsylvania Secretary of Education Eric Hagarty. The team's championship winning project was on display in the Governor's Reception Room.

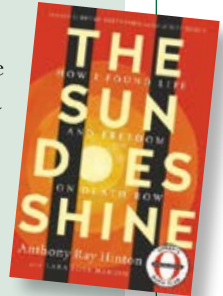
Focusing on Hunger, Poverty and Basic Needs

Through the Global Awareness Program, BSHS fosters the holistic formation of young men and women who are global citizens, imitating the love and compassion of Christ in all of their actions. One part of the program, the month-long Global Awareness Initiative held each February, focuses on important themes to help students study and learn from different cultures, and also to respond to the needs and problems around the world. This year's themes addressed hunger, poverty, and basic needs during Week One; violence and addiction during Week Two; education and employment during Week Three; and migration during Week Four. Students led their peers in live, educational simulations; charitable collections; morning and afternoon prayer; and live demonstrations in the hallway between classes, among many other activities.



One Book, One School: *The Sun Does Shine*

Each summer the entire student body reads a specially selected book as part of Shanahan's Global Awareness Program. Led by faculty, students will analyze and discuss the book in their classes throughout the school year ahead. Students will also have the opportunity to incorporate aspects of the book into unique class projects.



This year's book is *The Sun Does Shine: How I Found Life and Freedom on Death Row* by Anthony Ray Hinton. In 1985, Anthony Ray Hinton was arrested and charged with two counts of capital murder in Alabama. Stunned, confused, and only twenty-nine years old, Hinton knew that it was a case of mistaken identity and believed that the truth would prove his innocence and ultimately set him free. But with no money and a different system of justice for a poor black man in the South, Hinton was sentenced to death by electrocution. He spent his first three years on Death Row at Holman State Prison in agonizing silence—full of despair and anger toward all those who had sent an innocent man to his death. But as Hinton realized and accepted his fate, he resolved not only to survive, but find a way to live on Death Row. For the next twenty-seven years he was a beacon—transforming not only his own spirit, but those of his fellow inmates, fifty-four of whom were executed mere feet from his cell. With the help of civil rights attorney and bestselling author of *Just Mercy*, Bryan Stevenson, Hinton won his release in 2015.

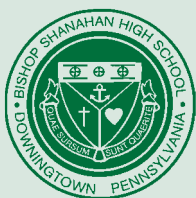

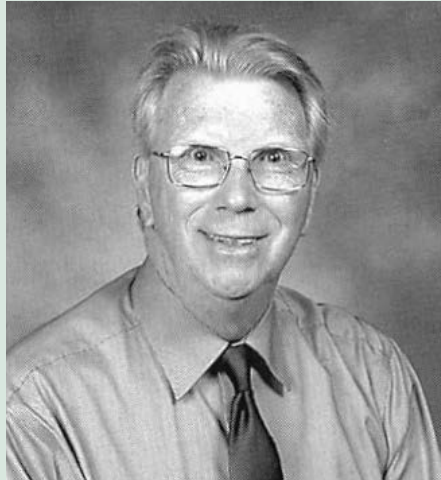
Mr. Hetherington '63 Retires after 55 Years of Teaching

At the conclusion of the 2021 – 2022 school year, esteemed teacher and alumnus, Mr. James Hetherington, retired after 55 years of service to Bishop Shanahan High School.

Mr. Hetherington, a 1963 graduate, starred as the drum major in the BSHS Marching Band during his time as a student. He also played saxophone, played on the boys' basketball team and ran track.

After graduating from college, Mr. H returned to Shanahan to become a teacher in the Social Studies Department. During his time teaching, he took an active role as a coach and moderator. From 1969 to 1979, he coached the girls' basketball team. In 1976 he served as the Director of Activities. From 1993 to 1994, he worked as the Students Against Destructive Decisions moderator (SADD). The Channel 2 Morning Show and all the Masses and performances in the auditorium would not be what they are today without Mr. H who served as Channel 2 moderator from 1994 to 2011 and the Audio Visual Director of 1995 to 2011. Mr. H could also often be seen attending multiple school events, activities, and sports games – all jam packed into the same week – as he captured photos and videos for the school, clubs, and teams.

In 2004, Mr. Hetherington was nominated for and won the Citadel Heart of Learning Award for the Non-Public School District.



“Mr. Hetherington embodies what it means to be a Catholic educator: selfless service and complete dedication to the learning and wellbeing of young people. He has inspired generations of Shanahan students to love history and love learning. His legacy looms large in our halls, and his impact continues to shape our community. Do You Pay PA Taxes and Want to Make a 10 Fold Impact?

It's easy to get a 90% tax credit AND help Shanahan students in need!

How Does It Work?

Receive up to a 90% tax credit against business or personal PA state tax liability by making a gift to Shanahan.

How Do I Join?

- Step 1:** Pledge a 2-year commitment (minimum of \$1,000 per year). The contribution amount is determined by your projected tax liability. One-year commitments are available for significant contributions that are a result of a windfall event, such as sale of business, property or other one-time spike of income.
- Step 2:** BSHS will connect you with a local Scholarship Organization (BLOCS or The Foundation for Catholic Education). The Scholarship Organization will notify you when to send the Year 1 contribution. This typically occurs in the fall.
- Step 3:** The Scholarship Organization will provide you with your K-1 so that you can use your 90% credit for the tax year in which the contribution was made. The process is very easy, and Shanahan is with you every step of the way.
- Step 4:** If you had been paying PA taxes all year long, you will receive a refund. Many people use the refund when writing the check for the Year 2 contribution.



Step 5: The Year 2 contribution will be made approximately one year following the first payment date.

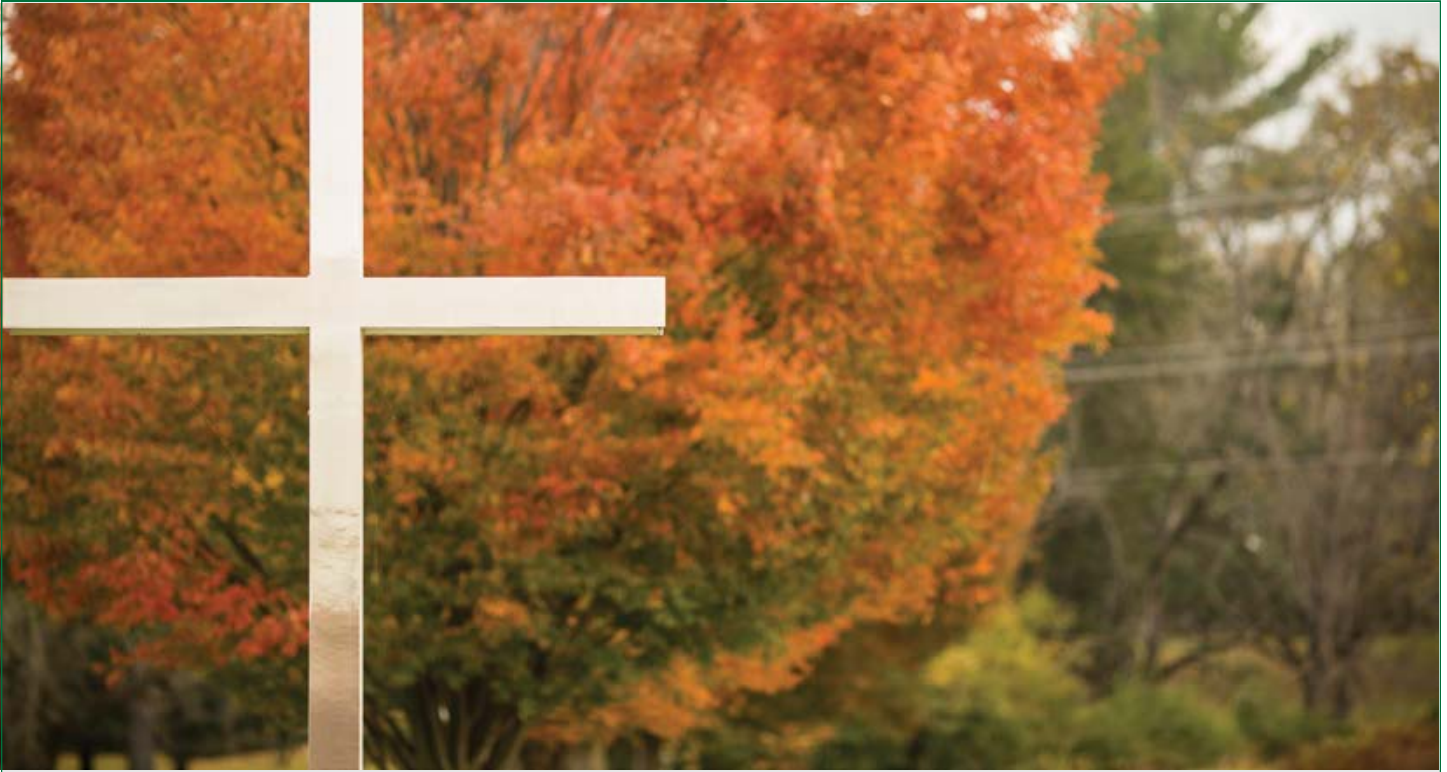
