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Description of Assessment, What is Assessed and Purpose of the SAEBRS and mySAEBRS:

SAEBRS is designed to help teachers determine students' social-emotional strengths and areas of need of further intervention. This assessment is completed by teachers. mySAEBRS is a student-rater companion assessment to SAEBRS, which allows students in grades 2-8 to self-assess their social, academic, and emotional behavior.

KIDS: Kindergarten Individual Development Survey

Completed within the first 40 days of In-PERSON school Data Entry Window Week of October 3

Description of Assessment, What is Assessed and Purpose of KIDS:

KIDS is an observation tool designed to help teachers understand the abilities and behaviors of our early learners. KIDS measures four domains: approaches to learning and self-regulation, social and emotional development, language and literacy development, and math cognition. Students are observed during play, work, and numerous other parts of the day.

ACCESS Testing for EL Students, Grades K-8

1/11 thru 2/28 Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing
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Description of Assessment, What is Assessed and Purpose of the ACCESS:

The ACCESS test is designed to assess student progress in achieving English language proficiency. Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing are assessed. The purpose of the test is to gauge student learning relative to content standards.

IAR, Grades 3-8

3/6 thru 4/21

Description of Assessment, What is Assessed and Purpose of the IAR:

IAR is designed to measure students' content knowledge and key skills of the Common Core State Standards. Students are assessed in English Language Arts and Math in grades 3-8 and Science in grades 5 and 8.

ISA, Grades 5 and 8

Description of Assessment, What is Assessed and Purpose of the IAR:

ISA is designed to measure students' content knowledge and key skills of the Next Generation Science Standards. Students are only assessed in grades 5 and 8.
