REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES PUBLIC HEARING BUDGET WORK SESSION Administration Building August 15, 2022 6:00 P.M.

The regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Bluffton-Harrison Metropolitan School District was held on Monday, August 15, 2022, with all members present. Also in attendance were Dr. Brad Yates, Superintendent; Julie Meitzler, Asst. Superintendent; Tammy Mechling, Corporation Administrative Assistant; Jessica Bricker, Corporation Communications Specialist; Steve Baker, Rick Mettler, Schlaura Linderwell, Administrators; Kole Meyer, Summer School Administrator & Elementary School Counselor; Vicki Van Matre, faculty member and BHTA co-president; Jinny Broderick, Jeff Kyle, Barry Crosbie, Robert Trexler, Joseph Streveler and Tim Garrett, interested patrons; and David Schultz, News-Banner representative.

The first order of business was to hold a public hearing (Correlated File #2223-02) to receive testimony in regard to teacher compensation and collective bargaining according to IC 20-29-6-1(b) which states, "before a school employer and school employees may privately negotiate the matters described in subsection (a)(1) [collective bargaining] during the time period for formal collective bargaining established in section 12 of this chapter, the parties must hold at least one (1) public hearing and take public testimony to discuss the items described in subsection (a)." Dr. Yates opened the floor for public comment and with no dialogue forthcoming, the Public Hearing was adjourned at 6:03 P.M.

Following the Public Hearing, and prior to the regular meeting, Dr. Yates presented a budget overview for the 2023 calendar year. The Board expressed appreciation to Dr. Yates for explanation of the budget overview and the Budget Work Session was adjourned at 6:22 P.M.

President Thompson called the meeting to order at 6:22 P.M.

President Thompson opened the meeting by expressing the Board's appreciation for everyone's efforts for a strong start to the school year and recognized the hard work over the summer by Mr. Bueter and our band students, who will host the Banks of the Wabash event on Saturday, September 10.

President Thompson called for public comment from Robert Trexler, who registered to speak prior to the meeting. Mr. Trexler asked to approach the Board and spoke in opposition of the employment recommendation for Karl Grau as HS Boys' Head Basketball Coach and Future Tigers Coordinator.

Minutes for the Regular Board Meeting held on July 18, 2022, were approved by consensus and appropriate signatures affixed thereon.

Vouchers for the period of July 19, 2022, through August 15, 2022, were approved by consensus and appropriate signatures were affixed on the voucher register.

The Fund Report for July was approved by consensus.

The Bank Statement for July was approved by consensus.

The Fund Transfer Report was approved by consensus.

Mr. Meyer reported on summer school and summer camps, with Mr. Baker reporting on high school attendance at summer school.

Mrs. Meitzler reported on new courses for the 2022-2023 school year and that Bus 15 should be back from repair in early September.

Dr. Yates reported on district projects, state and local student assessments, and an upcoming employee and retiree appreciation night on September 9.

Dr. Yates reported on teacher evaluation results for the 2021-2022 school year.

Dr. Yates reported enrollment numbers as of Friday, August 12, 2022. District enrollment has increased by 5 students in comparison to last year's first week of school, with an ADM count of 1,744 students.

Dr. Yates reported that on Wednesday, August 10, the State Board of Education approved the district's request to replace the existing electoral districts with residential districts for the upcoming election process.

Dr. Yates updated the Board on the Middle School Roof Replacement and Improvements Project and the High School HVAC Guaranteed Energy Savings Project. Phase one of the middle school improvements are completed with new classroom spaces and office areas finished, with bathroom areas being finalized soon. Phase two, which is the electrical upgrade and hallway carpet replacement, is scheduled to be completed over fall break. The high school HVAC work is almost completed and Dr. Yates presented a color coded map of the high school to show which areas are complete and which areas will be addressed as equipment arrives and school schedules permit installation efforts.
