Approve Budget Reduction Priority List

BACKGROUND: In January, the Governor proposed a state budget which resulted in estimated budget reductions of \$7.1 million in the Tracy Unified School District. The District Administration has been working on strategies to reduce the target amount. The 2008-09 District Budget Reductions Report was presented to the Board at the regular meeting of April 22, 2008, which included prioritized lists from the District Management Team, District Budget Advisory Committee, TEA, and the Superintendent.

RATIONALE: The value of all proposed reductions on the list is estimated to be \$5,527,975. At this time we are projecting \$3,418,730 as the amount to be cut from the prioritized list. This number may increase depending upon revisions made to the state budget. Tonight, the Board will formulate and approve the budget reduction priority list.

FUNDING: The value of the proposed budget reduction list is estimated to be \$5,527,975. The District is targeting the amount of \$3,418,730 as the amount to be cut from that list at this time.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve Budget Reduction Priority List.
