For Payment in Lieu of Transportation 2022-23 School Year

WHEREAS.

WHEREAS,

said pupils are legally entitled to transportation in accordance with ORC 3327.01 and 3327.02(A) and Northmont Board of Education policy 8600; and,

WHEREAS,

a thorough examination has been made of individual residence locations, number of students, existing bus routes, time schedules, and school locations and distances, resulting in the determination that to transport said pupils is an inefficient use of personnel and equipment.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that transportation service by school conveyance is declared to be impractical and that parents or guardians of each pupil shall receive payment in lieu of providing such service in an amount which shall not exceed the state reimbursement level.
