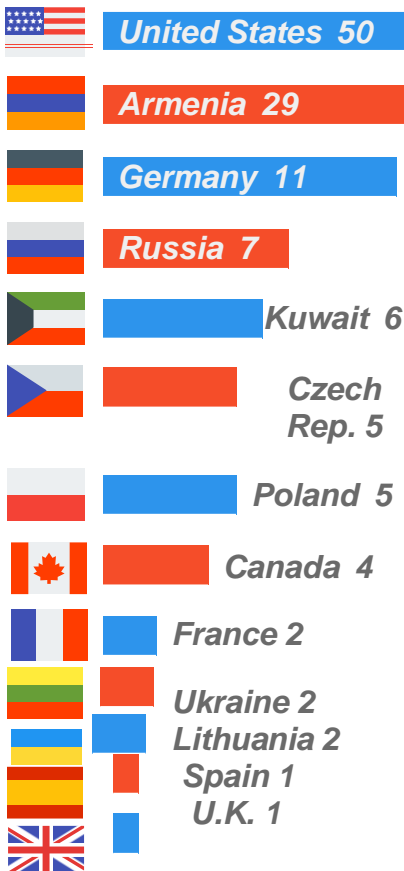

GPA and Class Rank

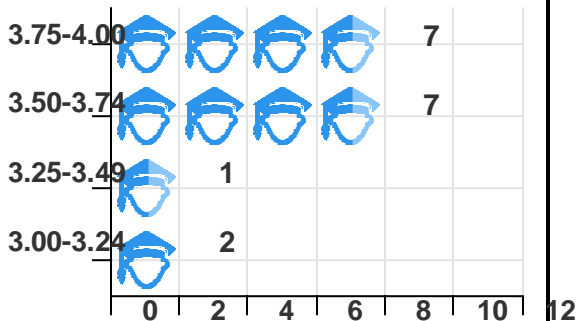
Due to the nature of the school and small class sizes, QSI International School of Yerevan does not rank students.

GPA Data

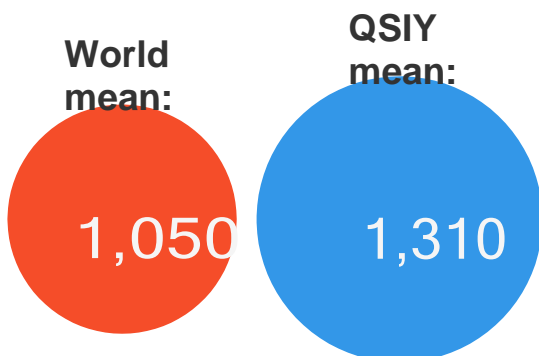
Cumulative GPA of currently enrolled Secondary III and IV students. Only QSIY grades are included

SAT Score Data

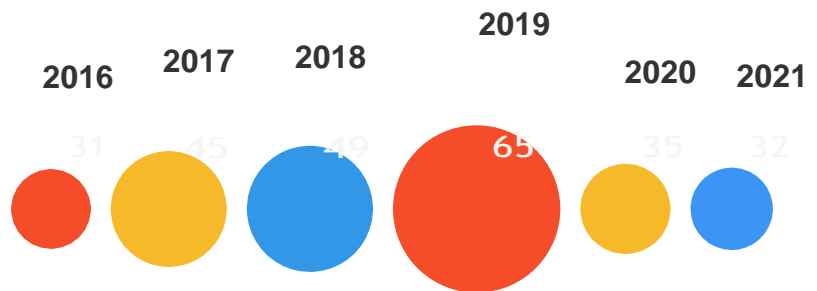
18 QSIY students took the SAT exam in the last two years. All scores, including those from non-native English speakers, are included.



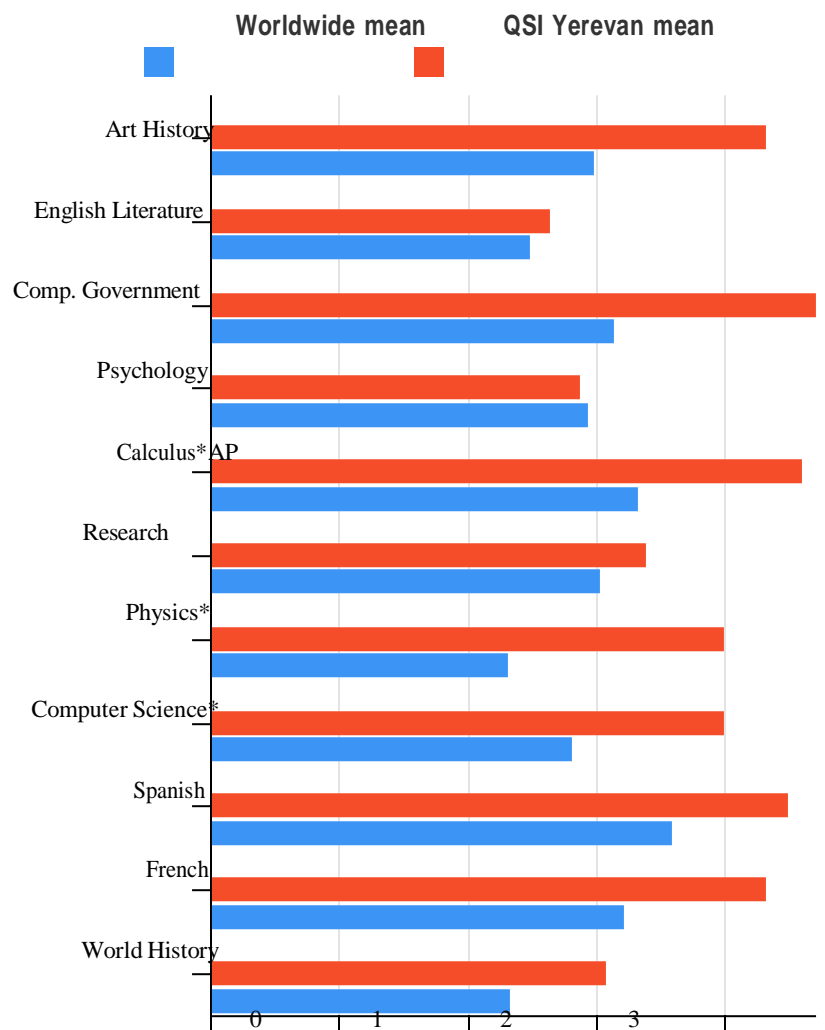
Advanced Placement Program

* the 2020 and 2021 numbers are partially explained by the transition to online testing for AP. Many students chose not to take the exams because of the new format. The pass-rate of QSIY remained an exceptional 85% regardless.

Grading System of QSI Yerevan

QSI International School of Yerevan is dedicated to the practice of mastery learning in all classrooms. Mastery of each essential unit is evaluated with a mastery grade. Detailed status reports are sent home five times a year.



A grade of "A" denotes a mastery of learning outcomes with demonstrated higher-order thinking skills.



A grade of "B" denotes a mastery of the learning outcomes at a basic level; students have the option to demonstrate higher level "A" mastery at a later time.










At QSI schools, mediocre or poor work, "C" or "D" level work in other schools, is not acceptable. Students will re-engage essential units until they have demonstrated mastery at the "B" or "A" level.

Units are the basis of grading and time periods (quarter, semester and term) are not evaluated.

Assessment is continuous and student performance is assessed on learning outcomes and units of study.
