College credit

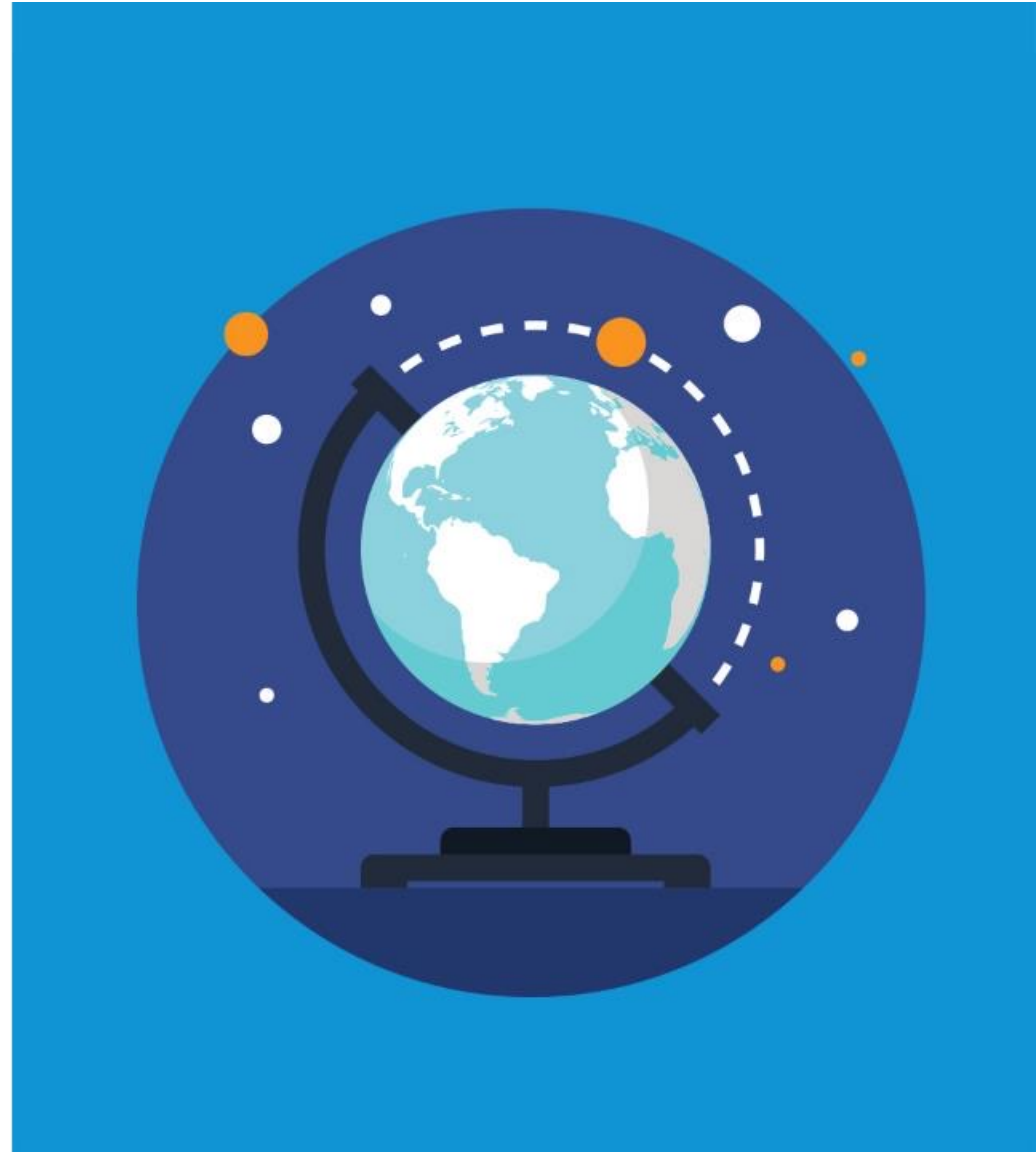
- Explorica partners with George Mason University for students to pick a course option for 1 college credit. They then work at their own pace to complete online classes within three months of the tour.
