

Dr. Michael Pratt: Position 2









For Kaitlyn Palividas, volunteering on community boards and managing a sales team is a natural fit for this former Tomball High School Cougar.

Her Tomball story began back in 2006 when her family moved to town. From there, she immediately became actively involved in school activities. During her time in Tomball, she attended Northpointe Intermediate, Willow Wood Junior High and Tomball High School, graduating in 2013.

In school, Palividas was a proud member of Tomball STAGE as well as the WWJHS Choir.

"The Tomball STAGE was a huge part of my high school experience. I made so many friends, both on stage and backstage, who were greatly impactful in my life. I also remember performing with WWJHS Choir at TMEA in San Antonio. It was such an incredible experience to perform in front of such a large group of Texas educators. I definitely look back on those memories fondly."

Her early success as a professional stems from her preparedness and time learning from her teachers in Tomball schools.

"One of my favorite aspects of Tomball ISD were the coursework and teachers," she said. "I always felt challenged and encouraged in my studies, which looking back I am so thankful for. My

teachers really prepared me for University and I owe so much of my success to them."

Palividas graduated from THS in 2013 and attended the University of Houston. From there, her community involvement continued.

"I was extremely active on campus through student organizations, ranging from community service to theatre to university recruitment."

Palividas took advantage of a graduate program at NES Fircroft as a senior in college, and was hired full-time once she graduated and has been with the company ever since.


