From the Chair of the Board

“I am extremely grateful to this community for the resilience, hope and promise you bring to our students’ educational journeys.”

Greetings Chadwick Community, The 2021–22 school year was a special one for me on a number of levels. My son, LeShaun, graduated with the Chadwick Class of 2022, and, as I reflect on his milestone, I also think of the milestones we have achieved at Chadwick.

In the spring of 2021, the Chadwick atmosphere was filled with uncertainty and concern, not only because the pandemic was still a significant impediment, but also because we were in the process of making our way through a crisis in leadership. While no one would have chosen these situations, they did demonstrate Chadwick’s remarkable RESILIENCE.

During this school year, we shared many positive experiences that I will characterize as rebuilding a sense of HOPE. We leaned into the leadership of Tom Sheppard as Interim Head of School; into a solid commitment to have in-person instruction and engagement while still recognizing the challenges of the pandemic; into community building through on-campus activities like the first-ever CPA Fall Festival, homecoming activities, sporting events and performing arts productions;



and into a Board commitment to reach out to and communicate with all members of the Chadwick community, including faculty and staff, parents, alumni and other past members of the community.

Dear Chadwick Community,
The 2021–22 school year created countless opportunities for us to come together in ways that have not been possible in quite some time. It reminded us all of the power of in-person connections and the emotional threads that create the fabric of the Chadwick community.

Our seniors in the Class of 2022 led the way in setting a remarkable tone on campus. They, and all of our students, embodied the joy, curiosity and growth that are at the heart of a Chadwick education. We’re proud of all our students and especially the Class of 2022, who received 428 offers of admission from 173 different colleges and universities.

The same spirit that propelled daily life on campus was felt throughout the community as we returned to in-person events such as Parent Coffees, Fall Brunch, Fall Fest, Spring Event, Family Day and, of course, Commencement. Many of these events would not have been possible without the support of our parents, and we are very grateful for that support.

We look forward with excitement as we work together to shape the future of Chadwick. Thanks to the efforts of the Strategic Planning Committee and those of the broader community, our strategic planning process is on track with a final plan scheduled to debut in Spring 2023. More broadly, our faculty and staff also continue to imagine the future through our Living and Learning Space Task Forces with the first outcomes from their efforts emerging across campus this fall in the form of enhanced outdoor spaces. Simultaneously, we are implementing an intentional and thoughtful year-long onboarding process for Jessica Donovan, who will join Chadwick as Head of School in July 2023.



More quantifiable signs of community health include 90 percent Annual Fund participation by current families, the highest level in five years. Annual Fund contributions from all members of our community were more than \$1.8 million, surpassing our goal. Simultaneously, retention for currently enrolled students stands at 95 percent, the second highest level in 10 years, and a level found only at the healthiest of schools.

The health of our community is a direct result of the support and commitment we receive from our parents. I would like to thank you for all that each of you has done this year to ensure a very bright future. Because of the commitment from our parents, donors and volunteers, we are able to continue to provide our students with an exceptional education.

PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

In April 2022, Chadwick launched a comprehensive strategic planning process, which will culminate in the development of the school's next strategic plan. The Roessler-Chadwick Foundation (RCF) Board of Trustees is leading our efforts, undertaking an inclusive process involving voices from our community and an extended period of reflection and learning. Through our work, we will identify our most important strategic priorities and initiatives to guide the school. The Strategic Plan will be shared with the Chadwick community in Spring 2023. The process began with creating the Strategic Planning Task Force, led by RCF Trustee Rachel Nguyen, and composed of trustees, alumni and Chadwick administrators. Through reflection on past strategic planning processes, the Task Force identified five areas for process improvements:

- Make the process visible to and inclusive of the multiple constituencies that make up the Chadwick School community.
- Establish and communicate a clear strategic vision.
- Involve community members to design and champion strategic objectives.
- Provide regular reporting on initiatives to the RCF Board.
- Share regular Strategic Plan progress updates with the broader Chadwick community.

The RCF Board of Trustees consulted with Chadwick community leaders to identify 22 individuals to serve on the Strategic Planning Committee, with Rachel Nguyen co-chairing the expanded committee along with Interim Head of School Tom Sheppard. These individuals represent trustees, administrators, faculty, staff, parents, alumni and students who are working together under the guidance of the RCF Board to lead our strategic planning process. They bring various skills, backgrounds and perspectives to our work, which they undertake on behalf of, and through the inclusion of, the entire Chadwick community. 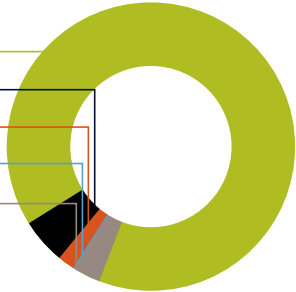

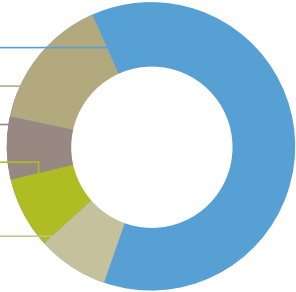

Gifts to endowed funds, including the general endowment, support the long-term growth of the school rather than current operations and are honored separately as well.

DESIGNING THE FUTURE

Innovative ideas and a world-class education have been a Chadwick hallmark for more than 85 years, and that focus continues today. The recently completed Innovation and Design Building (IDB) expands on-campus learning opportunities and is home to the Innovation and Design Department. The IDB houses a robotics lab, Makerspace, shop space, computer science lab, and flexible, easily-reconfigured collaborative learning spaces that provide an ideal environment for creative K–12 learning, innovation and construction. Dijanna Figueroa, Ph.D., Director of Innovation and Design, collaborates with K–12 faculty to facilitate cross-curricular experiences that reflect the intersections of science, technology, engineering, mathematics, and art and design (STEM/STEAM).

Beginning in kindergarten, students learn and apply STEAM concepts through a hands-on, iterative curriculum that provides real-time feedback to guide creation and building. Last year’s fifth graders, for example, used physics concepts to collaboratively design and create working paper roller coasters in the Makerspace. Using specific criteria, each group refined their designs, built their devices and presented them to a panel of judges for final testing.

From Village School science lab and Makerspace experiences to Upper School advanced robotics and digital design, students use the IDB to imagine and design future success.

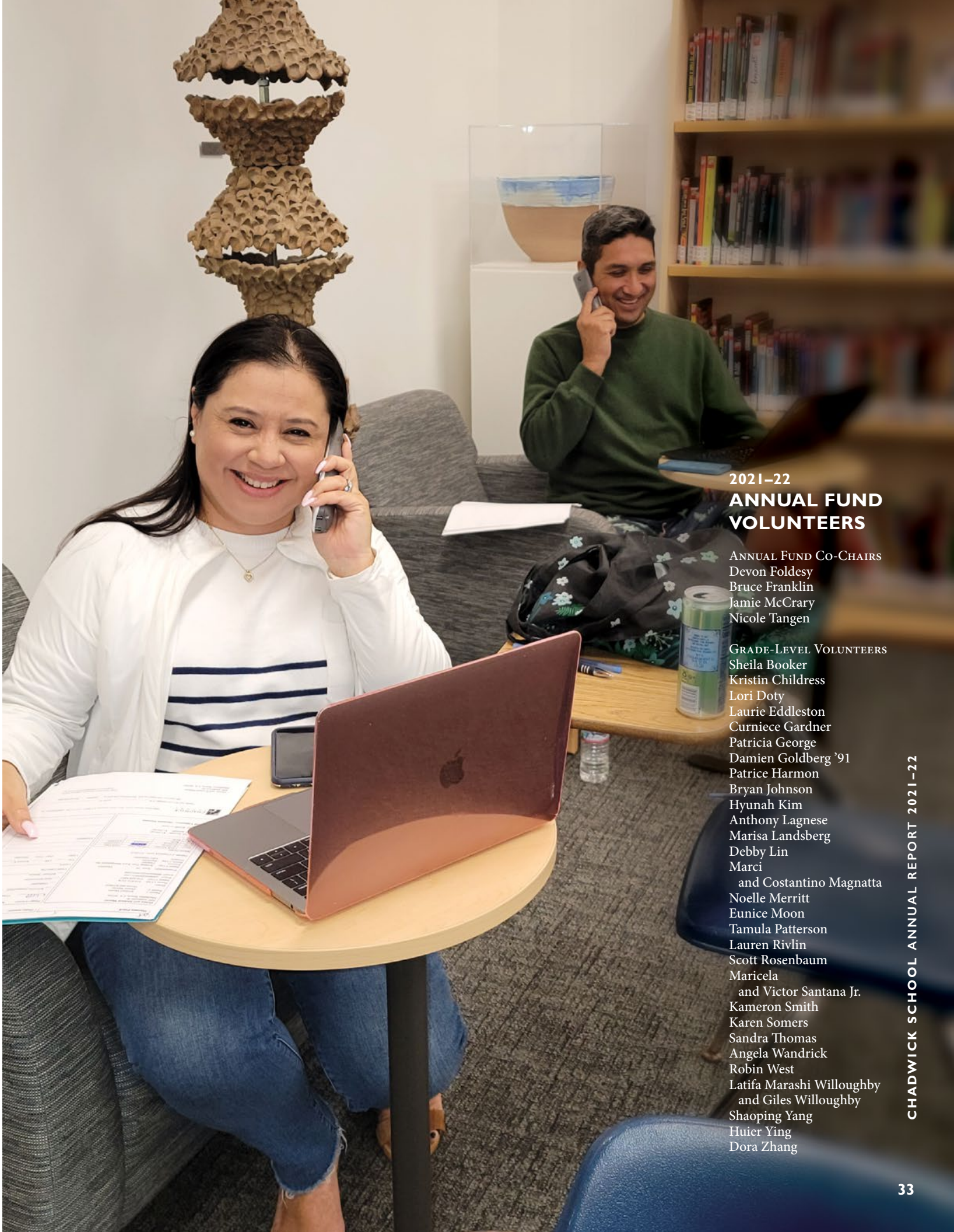

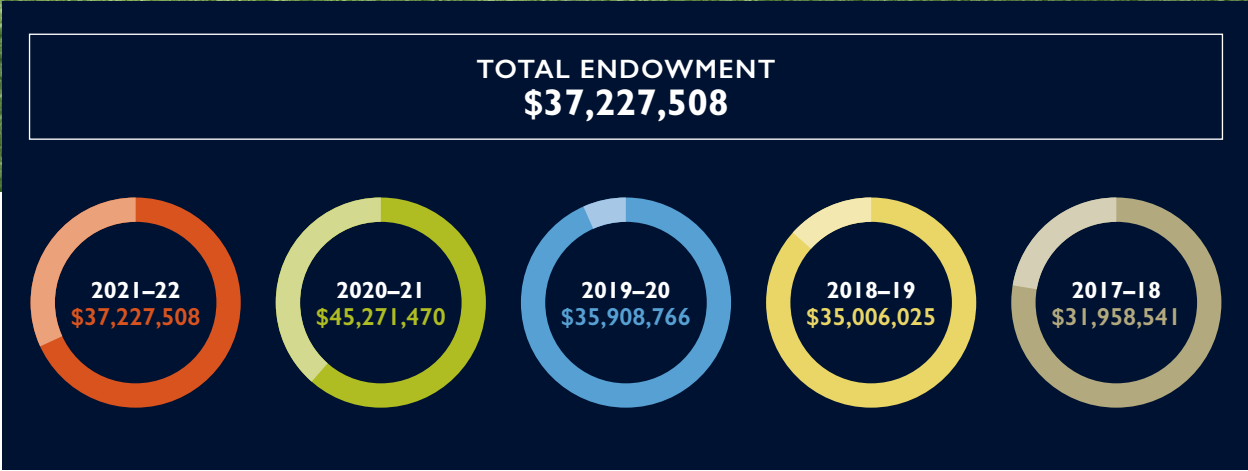
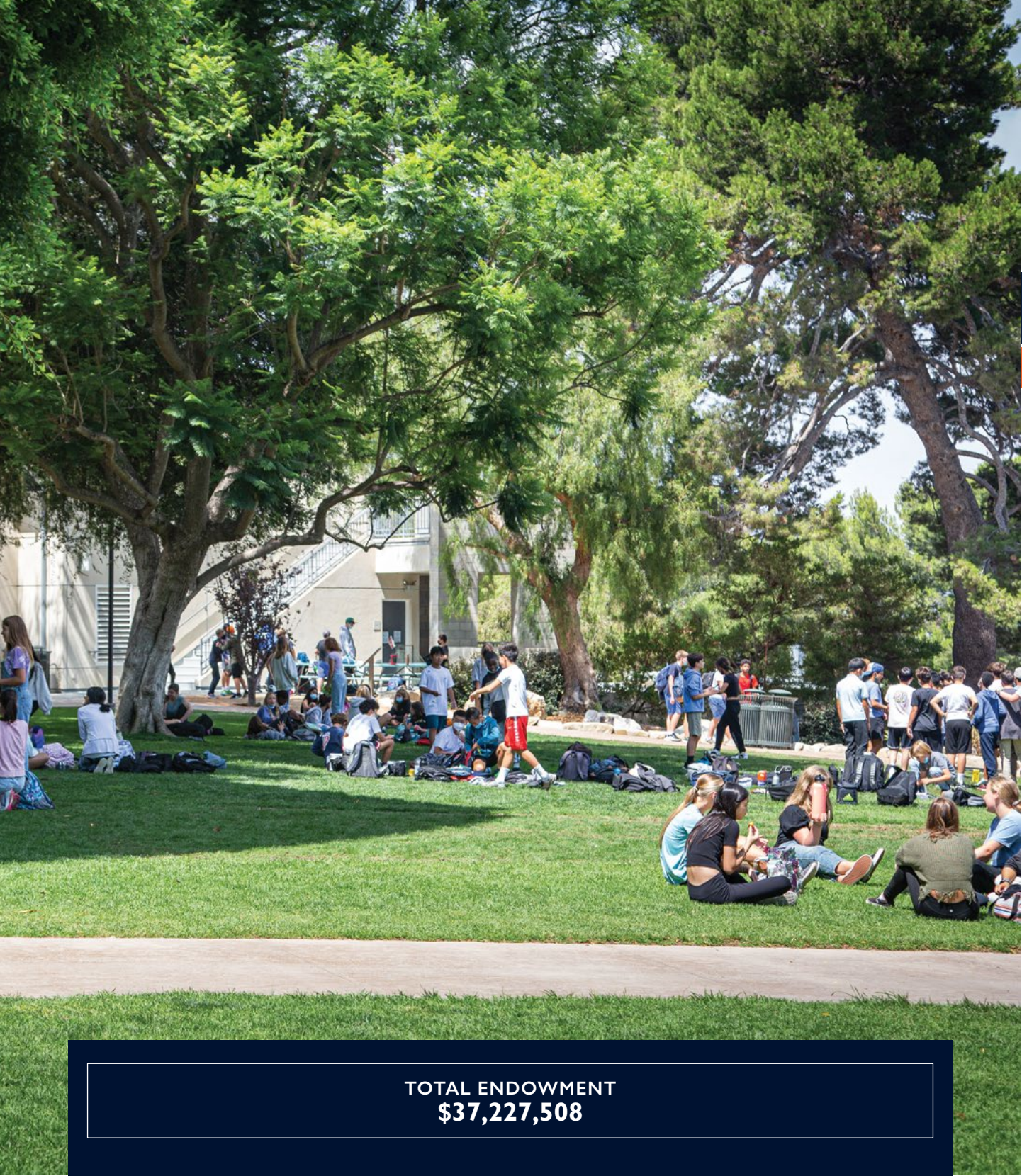

IN SUPPORT OF CHADWICK SCHOOL

What is a planned gift?

A planned gift reflects a donor's intention to make a major contribution to Chadwick that will extend beyond their lifetime.

What are the benefits of making a planned gift?

Planned gifts offer the donor the opportunity to support Chadwick in a meaningful way without giving a large outright gift. Planned gifts offer substantial tax savings to donors, especially on appreciated properties and securities. Often, a planned gift can reduce a donor's income tax obligation and/or avoid a capital gains tax.

What are the most common planned gift options?

Gifts for the Future — Planned gifts such as those listed below are "deferred" because Chadwick only receives the contribution after the donor's death. Planned gifts are fairly simple to arrange, usually requiring the donor to name Chadwick School as the beneficiary of part of their estate or retirement accounts.

- Wills and trusts
- Retirement plans
- Life insurance

Gifts that Provide Income — Life-income gifts require a long relationship between the donor and Chadwick School.

With these planned gifts, Chadwick receives a large donation, invests the funds, and pays an income to the donor for the rest of their life.

- Charitable gift annuities
- Charitable remainder annuity trusts
- Charitable remainder unitrusts

Gifts of Assets — Sometimes donors do not prefer to completely release their assets to Chadwick when making a gift. In these circumstances, donors can structure their gifts to provide significant organizational impact while still retaining an interest in the assets given.

- Charitable lead trusts
- Retained life estates

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

The mission of the Friends of the Library (FOL) is to promote literacy and the love of reading in the Chadwick community and to support the Chadwick Leavenworth Library and librarians. In addition to providing financial resources, FOL members sponsor visiting authors and illustrators; manage the Book Talks, Sneak Peek, and Parent and Student Book Club programs; organize and implement the Village School PALs library volunteers program; work with the Community Service program on literacy projects; and organize the keenly anticipated Chadwick Book Fairs. They give countless volunteer hours each year to support and enhance library and literacy programs in Grades K–12.

In 2021–22, the FOL redesigned the “Little Library” space on the Chadwick House porch with comfortable and functional furniture to allow K–2 students to read and play outside. Through the Classroom Book Donations program, the FOL provided more than 200 books and other materials to faculty members for classroom use. Additionally, the FOL partnered with Access Books and Chadwick’s Community Service program to create a library at an under-resourced local school by collecting gently used books from the Chadwick community. The group also hosted two in-person and three virtual presentations by renowned authors Karina Van Glasser, Caitlin Alifrienka, Raul the Third, Ernesto Cisneros and Nina Revoyr. In addition, the FOL coordinated a special event for more than 150 students, parents, faculty and staff members to hear Nobel Laureate Malala Yousafzai speak in Long Beach.

Chadwick gratefully acknowledges the Friends of the Library for their support of the school and its library and literacy programs.
