**1. Review of Committee Composition and Stakeholder Membership**

**2. Introduction of Social Worker and Clinical Services**

a. Presentation: TCHATT

Mrs. Amanda Muegge, TMISD Social Worker, gave an overview of her role and the duties and responsibilities she has. Specifically, her focus is on wraparound services, developing process and procedures for clinical services, and building partnerships/relationships with the community. Currently, TCHATT via UT-RGV is a provider of free clinical services via telemedicine. Each campus will have a designated location for the services. Students who need services will have the requester complete the TCHAAT referral packet.

**3. Coordinated School Health Program**

a. Presentation: CATCH

Yvonne Oliveira, Intermediate School PE Teacher, gave a brief presentation and overview of her classroom and the resources used to instruct physical education. Although CATCH was program she used in prior school years, it is something that has not been used in some time. If the district were wanting to go back to CATCH, it would require districtwide professional development and support for the program to work effectively. SHAC will continue to review CATCH and other possible CSHP programs during the Spring 2023 semester.

**4. Review and Update RIPICS Plan**

SHAC requested changes made to grammar and wording – from “as possible” to “when needed”. Other than grammatical updates, no other major changes were recommended or brought forth. As a result, SHAC approved the plan, according to the 6-month update requirement. The updated RIPICS plan has been posted to the website. The next review will be conducted in July 2023.
