SAT - What's the Deal??

- 80% of colleges and universities are currently test optional
 - Including: Harvard, Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Penn, Dartmouth, and Stanford
 - Data is being collected: Colleges drop SAT/ACT Requirement Test Optional List 2023
- The result would be monumental changes to the entire college application process
 - This could lead to:
 - less students taking the exam
 - less focus on test preparation
 - eventually testing could become a thing of the past(??)





Cohort Scores vs Academic Year Scores

Definitions:

- Cohort Scores include scores from an entire graduating class
 - Each student is counted once using the highest combined scores.

 Academic Year Scores include all students who took the test in that academic year. (11th, 12th, and potentially 10th and 9th)
