

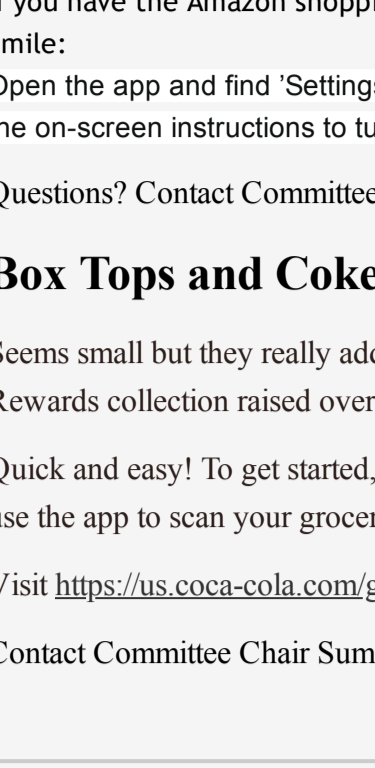

Picture retake day

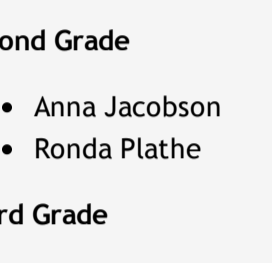
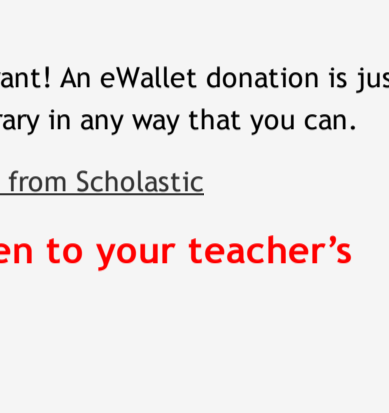
October 27 is picture retake day. You can order pictures at mylifetouch.com. Our picture day ID is EVTNP2V3.

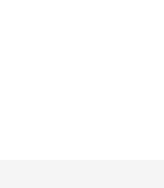
