The committee also reviewed the following parameters and conditions for developing the SY23-24 Academic Calendar:

- Consistent School Day (minimum of 460 minutes)
- Balanced Semesters
- 178 Student Days

- 187 Staff Days
- Low ADA Days
- "Banking" Minutes for School Day Closures
- Longer School Day and Trade Offs

The committee was also shared the following calendar development instructions:

- 1. Each campus will develop 4 calendars.
 - 2 calendars will utilize 6-week grading, with one calendar having NCJLS off.
 - 2 calendars will utilize 9-week grading, with one calendar having NCJLS off.
- 2. Each campus SBDM must have an opportunity to review all 4 calendars.
- 3. The SBDM will choose 2 campus calendars to move forward for DEIC review.
 - o 1 calendar with 6-weeks marking periods.
 - o 1 calendar with 9-weeks marking periods.
- 4. At the next meeting on January 26, 2023, the DEIC will select 2 calendars (1 6-weeks & 1 9-weeks) for the community to vote on.
- 5. The calendar with the most votes will be sent to the School Board for approval at the February 13, 2023 regular board meeting.
