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DESCRIPTION

The Crean Lutheran High School Chapter of the Science National Honor Society serves to encourage and recognize scientific and intellectual thought, to aid the civic community with its comprehension of science, and to encourage students to participate in community service and in turn, encourage a dedication to the pursuit of scientific knowledge that benefits all of mankind.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Second-semester sophomore or junior (will be a junior or senior next school year)
- Cumulative unweighted academic GPA of 3.70 or higher with an A average in honors/AP science coursework
- Must have completed at least three semesters of science at the honors or AP level
- Minimum of 30 total service hours prior to applying for the Honor Society
- Must be enrolled in a science class
- Students should demonstrate leadership, responsibility, respect, trustworthiness, and citizenship
- No incidence of academic dishonesty
- Complete the Science National Honor Society Application or Renewal Form by the deadline

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

- Attendance at monthly meetings
- Complete one or more projects per year
- Complete a minimum of 15 Science related service hours per year
- Students may choose a mentor teacher or teachers at Crean Lutheran High School that they will help for the school year with Lab Preparations (this can go towards their required service hours)
- Students can also volunteer for a SNHS tutor list - involvement in tutoring can go towards their service hours requirement (If on the tutoring list, student needs to have an "A" average in their science classes)
