

Rosenwald Collegiate Academy Enrollment & Next Steps Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Where can I learn more about the plans for 2023-24?

In addition to the family communication sent on Tuesday, December 13th (bit.ly/Fall2023RCAupdate), your teachers and administration will communicate additional engagement opportunities in January and throughout the spring.

Scholars who attend the school operated at the new Cohen facility will have access to a full gymnasium, a 300-seat auditorium, dedicated arts spaces, modern career and technical education spaces, and a large media center. Additionally, the proud Walter L. Cohen alumni are eager to support Cohen scholars on their path to success.

We look forward to having your child continue their high school education with us next year in the new Cohen facility!

What do families need to do?

Families currently enrolled at Rosenwald Collegiate Academy do not need to do anything. They are guaranteed a spot at the school that will operate at the new Cohen facility located at 3575 Baronne Street, New Orleans, Louisiana and will automatically be enrolled for the 2023-24 school year.

Will transportation be provided?

Yes, we will work closely with our transportation provider to ensure all students who need yellow bus transportation will have access in 2023-24.

Will families be provided uniform vouchers?

We will finalize the 2023-24 uniform requirements later this spring. The school recognizes the previous investment made in Rosenwald uniforms and will offset expenses by providing uniform vouchers to families who are returning in the fall to the new site.

What do families do if they prefer going to another school rather than Walter L. Cohen High School?

If you would prefer your child attend a different high school for the 2023-24 school year, please complete the NOLA Public Schools Common Application Process (NCAP) by the Friday, January 20, 2023 deadline.

If your child is **not** assigned to one of the ranked schools on your application, your child will be assigned to Cohen for next year. Families who prefer a different school option should rank a maximum of 12 school choices. Families can learn more at www.enrollnolaps.com and apply at oneapp.secure.force.com.
