- *Meetings will be arranged around your college schedule*

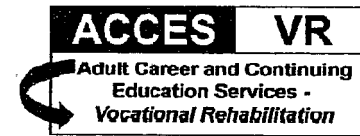

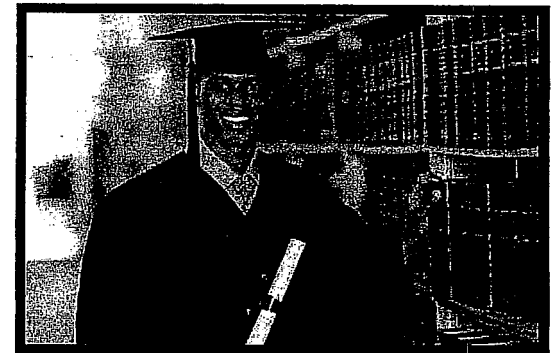
