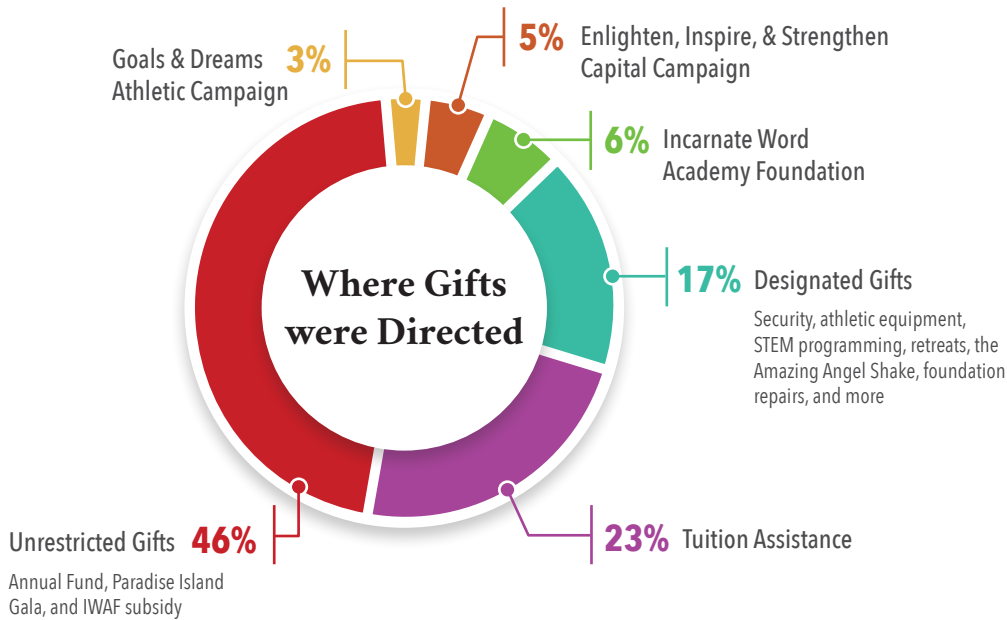


# Joy of Giving

## Fund Facts!



- **24%** of the unrestricted Annual Fund donors were President's Circle Members who collectively donated **80%** of the total annual funds raised.
- **72** first time donors gave to IWA.
- **136** gifts were given on #GivingTuesday providing **\$117,888** in support.
- **\$173,755** net unrestricted funds were raised through the special 150th Anniversary on-campus version of IWA's signature event, Paradise Island Gala. 
- **35%** of the 2021-2022 student body received need-based tuition assistance, totaling **\$540,579**.

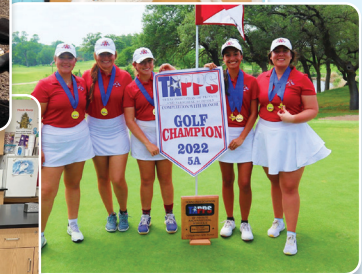
Angels impact our church and community every year by providing donations and many hours of community

service. They strengthen their faith by participating in spiritual retreats, weekly Masses and other sacraments on campus throughout the year.

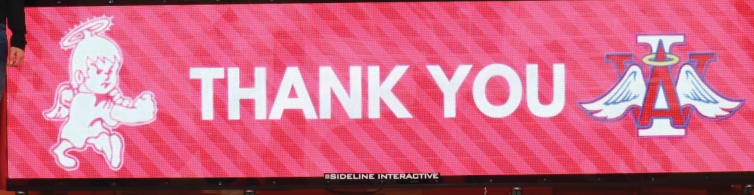
