

Baptisms are held on the 1st Sunday of the month in english. Please call the parish office at least 2 months in advance. Sponsor letters are necessary for Godparents and must be confirmed and practicing Catholics in good standing with all their sacraments of initiation. 



#### DANNY ESPINO APPOINTED TO AND SWORN INTO MIAMI-DADE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

November 28, 2022

On November 22, 2022, Danny Espino took the oath of office to join the Miami-Dade County School Board as the representative for District 5. Board Member Espino was appointed by Governor Ron DeSantis to fill an unexpired term, succeeding Board Member Christi Fraga. In naming Board Member Espino, Governor DeSantis stated, "[the] appointment is evidence of my utmost confidence in [Mr. Espino's] ability to serve with excellence and distinction, " finding Mr. Espino to be a qualified and ethical individual.

Currently a partner in the law firm of Bercow Radell Fernandez Larkin & Tapanes, Mr. Espino has had a long career in public service. He was elected to two terms to the City Council for the City of Miami Springs and served for more than a decade as City Attorney in and for several Miami-Dade County municipalities, including several District 5 cities—City of Doral, City of Miami Springs, and Town of Medley. Mr. Espino is a lifelong resident of Miami Springs, a District 5 city, where he resides with his wife. Barbie, and their four boys.

On his new role, Board Member Espino stated: I take up this position on the School Board with the same clarity of purpose and care that I dedicate to being a parent. It's never been more difficult to be a parent in the United States, and there's never been a more critical time for parents to play a central role in education. I'm proud to contribute my voice to that.

Mr. Espino has been involved with the Blessed Trinity community his entire life. He attended Blessed Trinity Catholic School from Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, graduating in 1997. He has been a lifelong parishioner of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church. His boys are following his faith journey, receiving their sacraments as Blessed Trinity as well. Mr. Espino attended his Emmaus Retreat in 2009.

Board Member Espino will serve the remainder of Ms. Fraga's term, which concludes in 2024.
