College & Career Readiness Day Tuesday, January 17th

Throughout the spring there are a variety of ways that we either assess or prepare students for college and career opportunities. Some of these are state required measures (PSAT, WIDA, CMAS) while others are part of curriculum (Advanced Placement) or future class options (Accuplacer). By taking a day early in the semester we can start to fulfill some of the requirements, prepare for upcoming opportunities, and increase exposure to the expectations our students need to understand.

Lunch Hour - we will be catering a lunch with food from local restaurants and our own catering class to feed our students and staff.

We will have a special daylong schedule to accommodate everything we want to accomplish around college and career readiness. On this day students will be involved in a variety of required or practice exams along with exposure to career opportunities. Here is a list of exemplars of the variety of areas that will be addressed:

WIDA/Access - required test for our English Language Development students

Advanced Placement - practice tests for AP students with their AP teacher to measure how well students have mastered the content and skills of a specific AP course.

PSAT - practice test for 9th & 10th grade students that serves as baseline for college readiness

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SAT - practice test for 11th grade students to measure a high school student's readiness for college, and provide colleges with one common data point to compare all applicants.

Accuplacer - a series of tests that evaluate students' skills to determine placement in our dual enrollment courses through CMC

ACT Workkeys - career readiness exam for students interested in our internships and workplace experience programs

ASVAB - Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery entrance for students interested in military careers

Internships & Careers - local businesses and government agencies will be here to talk about and demonstrate what they have to offer and how students can access careers in various fields.

This will be happening quickly at the start of 2nd semester. We will be communicating with students about the opportunities they have to use that day and the logistics of how it will all work. It starts before the Winter Break with surveying students about the options. It will continue the week we return in January with specific preparations.

We are excited to offer this important day and look forward to making it meaningful for all our students.



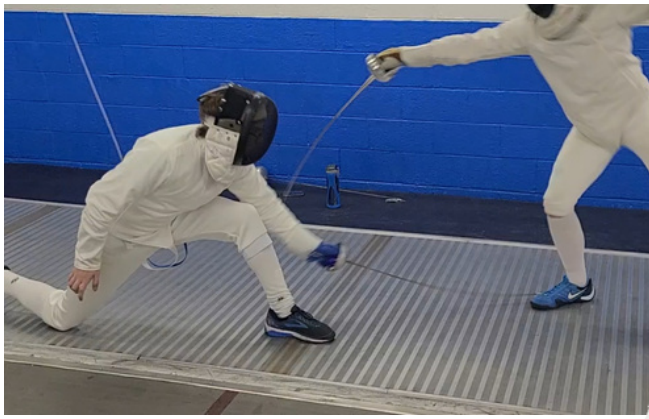

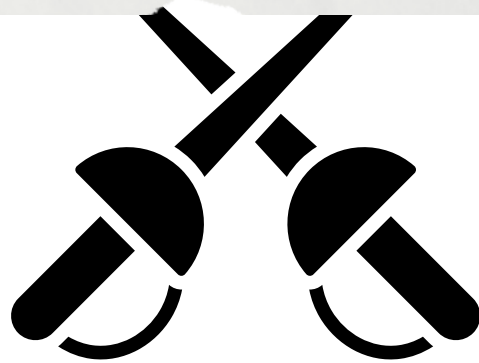


As a parent, if you are not receiving text messages from your school, it means you need to "Opt In" for text messages. You can do this by texting the word "yes" to 87569.
