



Permission to Borrow a Hotspot Form from School Learning Commons

The Francis Howell School District Learning Commons has hotspots available for checkout to students who do not have internet access at home to help facilitate the completion of assignments. The loan period is one month with the option of renewal, if available. A late fee of \$1.00 per day will be charged if the hotspot is not returned on time.

A tamper-proof security seal has been placed over the reset button for your protection. In the event that this should be damaged and the hotspot reset, it must be returned to the Learning Commons immediately. Should the hotspot be reset intentionally, disciplinary action will be taken.

To participate, students must read and agree to the following statement:

I agree to abide by the Francis Howell School District Network and Internet Acceptable Use Policy (Policy 6320) guidelines found in the Student Code of Conduct when using any District-provided device while in school, at home, or any other place.

It is the policy of the District to (a) prevent user access over its computer network to, or transmission of, inappropriate material via Internet, electronic mail, or other forms of direct electronic communications; (b) prevent unauthorized access and other unlawful online activity; (c) prevent unauthorized online disclosure, use or dissemination of personal identification information of minors; and (d) comply with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA).

I understand that I am responsible for the device assigned to me and that I am expected to return the device in the same condition in which it was received. The cost to replace a lost or damaged hot spot is \$60. I agree not to allow other students to use the device while it is checked out in my name. Hotspots are equipped with a basic CIPA filter managed by the telecommunications carrier. If the filter is not functioning correctly, please return to the school learning commons.
