**Policy Statement**

It is the policy of the Trumbull Board of Education that Honors and Advanced Placement classes will receive weighted grades for purposes of calculating and determining class rank.

## 6146.11/Weighted Grades for Honors and Advanced Placement Classes Grades 9-12

### Regulations

1. Rank in class is a method of listing students numerically according to their academic achievements. Rank is calculated at the end of the sixth and seventh semesters.
2. Rank is determined using the following grade conversion:

A+ = 4.33	A = 4.0	A- = 3.67
B+ = 3.33	B = 3.0	B- = 2.67
C+ = 2.33	C = 2.0	C- = 1.67
D+ = 1.33	D = 1.0	D- = 0.67
F = 0		
3. For a class that meets five times per week, a weight value of .05 (.0625 for lab science) is added to the final cumulative Quality Point Average for each full-year Honors course and .025 for each semester Honors course.
4. Advanced Placement courses are weighted at .07 (.0875 for lab science) for each full-year course and .035 for each semester course.
