

Selection Process

All former George Stevens Academy student-athletes, coaches, administrators, and special contributors are eligible for selection into the athletic hall of fame. The candidate must receive four out of the seven votes possible from the selection committee to gain status as an inductee into the hall of fame.

Criteria for Student Athletes

1. Superior accomplishments as an athlete at George Stevens Academy: All-State, All-Conference, or other significant accolades.
2. A graduate of GSA at least five years prior to nomination.
3. Continuing excellence at the collegiate, national, amateur, or professional level.
4. Clearly demonstrated integrity, sportsmanship, and citizenship before and after graduation.
5. Academic and post-college career accomplishments.

Criteria for Coaches, Administrators, and Special Contributors

1. Significant contributions made to the athletic program, taking into account years of service, overall coaching records, and championships.
2. Significant contributions to community or professional organizations that promote athletics at the state or national levels.
3. Retirement from their positions at GSA.
