### **Reading Tips for Parents**

- 1.) Read with your child everyday.
- 2.) Be a reading role model. Children who see their parents reading want to read too.
- 3.) Allow students to read aloud and think aloud.
- 4.) Provide a variety of reading materials in the household. Allow students to read topics that interest them.
- 5.) Let your child be the teacher. Allow them to ask you questions. What do you think will happen next?

- 6.) Allow for more reading time and less TV time.
- 7.) Make frequent trips to the library.
- 8.) Ask your child questions as you read with them.
- 9.) Praise reading progress and skill development.
- 10.) Provide a quiet, comfortable place in the home for the student to read.
