- 1.) Be positive about math and praise your child's math abilities.

- 4.) Communicate with your child's teacher about math skills to focus on.
- 5.) Ask questions and encourage student to share what they know about math.
- 6.) Make a quiet, comfortable place in your home for learning.
- 7.) Show your child a list of careers and how each applies mathematics to their work.
- 8.) Allow your student to be the teacher.
- 9.) Spend time with word problems and math vocabulary.
- 10.) Incorporate technology into math studies at home.
