First, as part of an overall upgrade to our network infrastructure, we have added several security cameras in key places inside and outside our buildings. Our new system has the capability to support more cameras, so we will add to it as funds allow. Currently, we have coverage in the areas we think are most important for campus security.

Over the summer, we completed an internal review and update of our emergency and crisis plans. This fall, we will complete a more thorough update in close conjunction, as always, with our local first responders and the Hancock County Emergency Management Agency to be certain all our procedures reflect current best practices and the preferences of our local agencies. We will go over our crisis plans with students in the first few days of school, and will conduct emergency drills during the fall.
