My Vatican Christmas Angel

I had just graduated from college and was traveling to Europe for the first time to meet up with two friends. Barbara was in Montpelier, France for her junior year in college, and Cindy was teaching French in Rouen, France. They both met me in Rome, Italy a few days before Christmas to travel around Rome and to attend Midnight Christmas Mass at the Vatican.

Throughout the four days prior to Christmas Eve, we each would see the same lady wherever we went; from the coffee bar in the morning, to a sight later, to a street corner at lunch. She

was obviously following us. Finally, in the gift shop on Via della Conciliazione, the lady came up to me and asked if we were planning on going to midnight Mass, and did we have

our ticket? Ticket?? None of us knew we needed a ticket!

She directed us go to the 10th column on the right side of St. Peter's Square at 3:00 pm. Although we were taken by surprise by this strange lady, we thought, "What do we have to lose?" Sure enough, at 3:00 pm, we went as directed and discovered a person standing there who simply said, "At 5:00 pm there will be a monk standing in front of the walled-up Holy Door" (the entrance into the Vatican) and upon our arrival, we were to inform him that we were sent to see him.

Now, the story gets stranger . . . The monk wanted to know how we knew to see him. He gave us a piece of paper with someone's name written on it and said, "Tomorrow (December 24, 1981) at 11:00 am, go the entrance to the Papal Palace. There will be two Swiss guards. Hand them this piece of paper." Again, at 11:00 am the next day, we went as directed and handed the Swiss guard the piece of paper. He then walked us a distance and brought us into the Papal Apartments. Sitting in an alcove, behind a highly ornate writing desk, was a Monsignor. He looked up at the three of us, said nothing and handed us three beautifully engraved red and gold tickets. We were then ushered out

> of the Papal Apartments, simply stunned, although not able to read the Italian on the tickets. We soon discovered that Pope John Paul II had stated that a small section (4 chairs wide and

about 30 seats back) around the main altar of St. Peter's was to be reserved for the "people of God". The three of us were the first to go through the metal detectors and we found ourselves sitting in the front row, next to the Papal Choir, for Midnight Mass. Pope John Paul was only five steps away from us as he was exiting Mass, and stopped and blessed rosaries that I held out to him.

There is no doubt, 41 years ago, a Christmas Angel followed us around Rome those days.

GET BOOKS FOR FREE

You can build out your library with a computer or tablet. Electronic book demand has surged during the pandemic, and no wonder. You can skip a trip to a library or bookstore, just download a book to your tablet, smartphone, or computer. Can't read tiny print? Simply tap or click to make it larger. Many public libraries lend books; if you're not already borrowing them, ask a librarian to help get you started. And there are some other good sources for free digital books.



For classical works, there's **Project Gutenberg**. This nonprofit library digitizes books whose copyrights have expired and are now in the public domain. On its website, <u>Gutenberg.org</u>, scroll down to "Find Free eBooks" and follow the prompts.

For history, go to the **Library of Congress**. Without traveling to DC, you can read many rare and important works, like a Chinese history collection or a Babe Ruth biography written by one of his Yankee teammates. You can also browse old playbills, judicial opinions, newspapers and more. Go to loc.gov/collections.

For romance novels there's **Harlequin Online Reads**. Every week, this publisher posts chapters of new books written by its authors. Create a free account, then click on the book you want to read. 
