

Erin's Law

Mandated in all Illinois Public Schools
Public Act 097-1147

There are 42 million sexual abuse survivors in America; 3 million are children, which would fill 46 national football stadiums.

93 percent of children know their abuser; 7 percent is by a stranger.

1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys are sexually abused before the age of 18.

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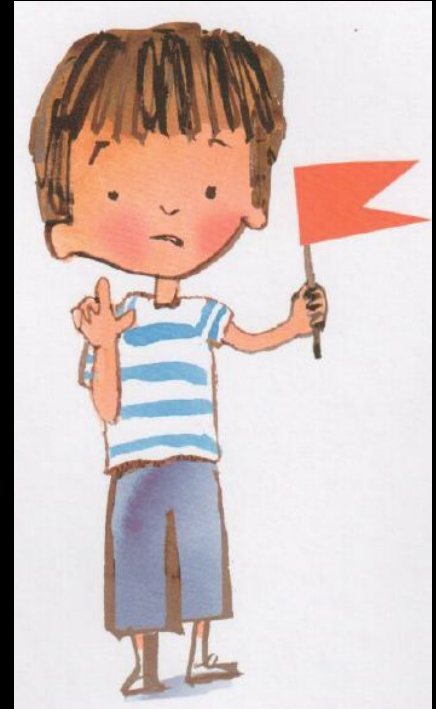

3. information to share with parents



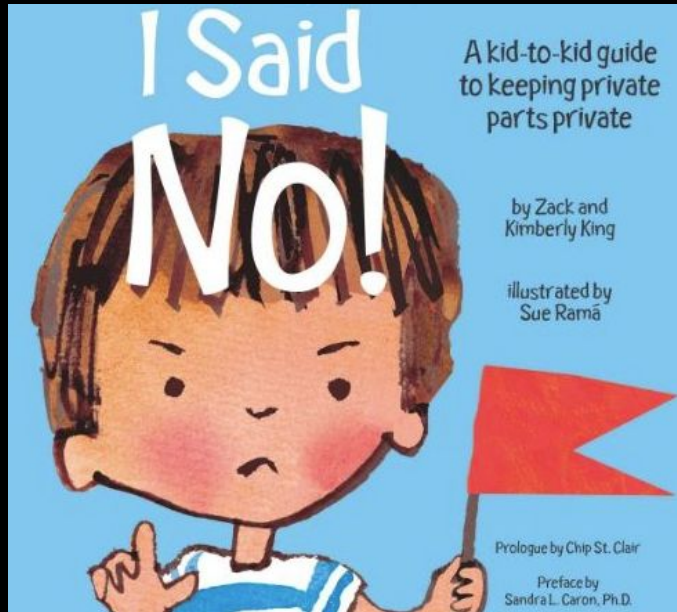

WHAT IFS

Scenarios will be shared across the grade levels to give students practice.

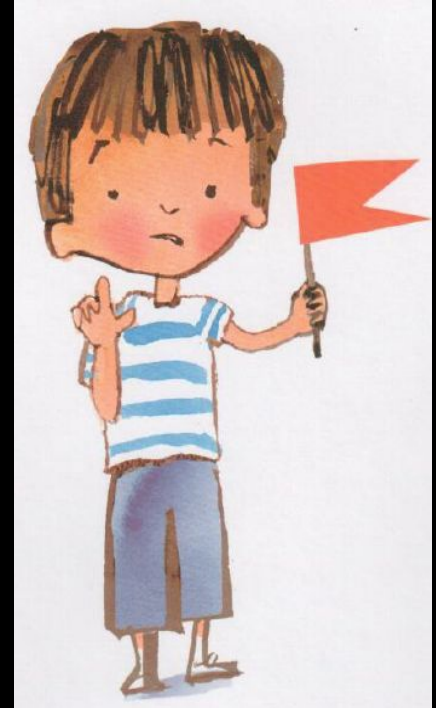
NO...GO...TELL

1. Yell "NO!"
2. GO away as quickly as possible
3. TELL a trusted adult



6th - 8th Grade

1. age-appropriate instruction every year included with SEL and Health Class lessons
 - a. recognize and report abuse
 - b. reduce vulnerability
2. additional lessons on dating violence



In addition to student sessions...

1. Training of school personnel prior to the student sessions.
2. Parent letter will go home prior to the learning sessions.
3. Talking points for parents with resources/links will be shared.
