Re/Enrollment Fee. This annual fee places the student on the school roster, thereby confirming their re/enrollment at BCS. It is due upon re/enrollment and **non-refundable** once billed or paid. The re/enrollment fee is not a deposit on, nor a prepayment of, tuition.

Priority Re-Enrollment. Open only to current BCS students re-enrolling for the 2023-2024 school year. Tuition accounts must be current. Open enrollment begins January 24 for all new families wishing to enroll in BCS. Returning students not reenrolled by January 23 may be waitlisted; students reenrolling after January 23 pay the open enrollment fee.

Annual Tuition. Bellevue Christian charges annual tuition due May 1. Payment plans are offered as an alternative to making payment in full. All payment plans listed here are governed by BCS tuition payment and withdrawal policy, outlined below, and the enrollment contract.

- One-Pay A: paid in full by May 1, 2023, with a 2% discount. Option to pay by BCS-managed ACH with prior arrangement, bank bill payment, or through Veracross portal (VC Pay). Discount expires May 2. VC Pay convenience fees apply.
- One-Pay B: paid in full by May 1, 2023 by wire or Flywire (international funds). Does not receive 2% discount.
- Two-Pay: Installment 1 is due on or before May 1, 2023, paying 50% of annual tuition; Installment 2 is due on or before October 1, 2023, paying 50% of annual tuition. Does not receive 2% discount. Pay by check, bank bill pay, BCS-managed ACH, wire, Flywire, or VC Pay. VC Pay convenience fees apply.
- Tuition assistance not available.

***Required Tuition Account Deposits** for student's I-20 and expenses during the school year. Deposit for **new student I-20** (\$5,000) is per-student, is non-refundable, is a deposit on annual tuition, and reduces May 1 payment. (I-20 deposit not required for returning students.) Deposit for **expenses** for all students as follows:

- ◇ **Grades K-6.** Expense deposit of \$500 per family. If family has a student in grades 7-12, the elementary expense deposit is waived.
- ◇ **Grades 7-12.** Expense deposit of \$1,000 per student.

Expense deposit is replenished each year. Expense deposit remaining in tuition account after paying all fees or tuition is refunded at graduation or withdrawal.

NOTE: Bus fee, insurance, and textbooks are not covered by the expense deposit.

JH/SH Textbooks/Workbooks. Most purchased separately by family after student schedules are published in summer and booklists are made available on the parent portal. BCS purchases and delivers to the student some required workbooks as identified in Academic Handbook; family invoice is charged.

Payment Terms

- One-Pay A or B, or Installment 1 is due by May 1 and will avoid late fees if payment is received by May 5.
- Installment 2 is due by October 1 and will avoid late fees if payment is received by October 5.
- All unpaid accounts will be subject to monthly late fees totaling \$65.
- Any payment returned for any reason will be subject to a \$25 fee.
- Bank and card payments made through VC Pay will be subject to convenience fees.
- Students may not attend classes or participate in co-curricular activities beginning the first day of school and/or second semester, if payment has not been made by due date.

Force Majeure. In the event of school closure beyond the school's control, the School's duties and obligations will be postponed until such time as the School, in its sole discretion, may safely reopen and/or comply with its duties and obligations. Details are found in online re/enrollment. A full description is part of the enrollment contract.

Separation from School; Payment Policy. If a student withdraws after they have enrolled, tuition and fees accrued through the end of the month of withdrawal based on the withdrawal chart below are due regardless of the date of actual withdrawal. Tuition will be calculated based on a 10-month installment plan for the period of May 1 through September 30. Refunds only for payments made over and above tuition and fee responsibility. Tuition responsibility is as follows:
