NEW BUSINESS- PRESENTATIONS FOR APPROVAL:

- Peer Physics
 - An introductory physics curriculum that focuses on learning physics through evidence. The professional development part of the curriculum encourages the teaching style to change from a teacher centered class structure to a student-centered classroom.
 - Sponsors: Chris Asmann/ Teacher, Bothell High School
Kevin McDonald/Teacher
 - Teaching to 9-12 graders, Physics through Evidence Empowerment through Reasoning-
 - Curriculum Category: Supplemental Materials
 - Core Material being Supplemented: NSD Physics Curriculum

- Needs being met: POGIL Science Curriculum
- Satisfies all NGSS Standards and Engineering Design Challenge requirements
- Ready-To-Go curriculum and activities for teachers new to physics, and the online materials match the in-class lessons; fits in with Schoology
- Nothing is being replaced
- All students can learn using this curriculum
- Goal: students figure things out on their own instead of being told right or wrong; science-based facts and evidence.
- Field Testing: last 3 years at BHS. Students enjoy learning through doing activities, high level of engagement.
- Professional Development Needed: first year week long PD, with 4 follow up day sessions; Second year 4 day sessions.
- Other benefits: designed to interest students rather than fit a textbook; inclusive by design; students teaching themselves (and other students) is more effective way for learning.
- Contingencies: needs a DRR (Digital Review) @ShelbyReynolds

Motion: I move that PEER Physics as district supplemental for grades 9-12 in the content area for physics, by Rebecca. Seconded by Greg Cox. No opposed, motion carries.

- Choices Program

- Materials from Brown University that draw connections between historical events and national and international issues. Choices Program materials address specific topics within US History, World History, and Current Events. They also provide professional development resources intended to help teachers strengthen essential skills and helping students sharpen their analytical skills.
- Sponsor: Jennifer Ligot/Teacher, North Creek High School
 - Was approved in 2012-13; used in the district for decades as a highly regarded resource within the social studies discipline.
 - Since it's previous approval, Choices has updated its format to a subscription-based digital service, which has allowed it to expand and update it's offerings. The current adoption is now out of date.
 - Slideshow has list of examples of country-specific world history and geography titles.
 - CWP modules- US Foreign Policy examples, topics and issues.
 - Newer Professional Development and Resources (teacher centered/teacher facing).
 - Multiple Access Points for students
 - Overview of Pilot Program:
 - Digital now- cost for a 5-yr site subscription is \$3500
 - Site license info (based on site enrollment not course enrollment)

Rebecca motions that we approve the update The Choices Program (2022) as district supplemental for grades 9-12 in the content area of Social Studies, with the conditions that the online resources are reviewed every five years through the Curriculum and Instruction Department for major changes. Seconded by Greg Cox, no opposed. Motion carries.
