

## Vengu Family Memorial Scholarship

The Vengu Family Scholarship was created by Georgetown Community Hospital to honor the memory of Dr. Narayan Kumar “Dr. Vengu” Venguswamy and his wife, Jayanthy Venguswamy. Dr. Vengu was a member of the Georgetown hospital medical staff for 27 years. This scholarship is available to graduating seniors from Scott County who intend on pursuing a degree in the medical field or in photography. Two recipients will each be awarded a non-renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Student must be a current high school senior attending a public high school in Scott County, KY
- Student must have a minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Student must intend on pursuing a degree in the medical field or in photography
- Student must attend an accredited four-year college or university and be enrolled full-time during the upcoming fall semester
- Student must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities and/or community service
- Preference will be given to applicants with financial need

## Required Documentation

- **Transcript of grades**
- **Complete Student Aid Report (SAR)** – After submitting your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), you will be able to log back into your FAFSA account and access your Student Aid Report (SAR) within 3 – 5 business days. You will be able to download a copy of the report and this is what you will need to upload with your application.
- **Resume** – a list of extracurricular activities, work experience, community service, and/or family/household responsibilities with which you are involved.
- **Estimated Cost of Attendance** – this is an estimate of what you can expect to pay for one year of school. This includes tuition and fees, room and board, books, and supplies. This estimate can typically be found on the website of the college you plan to attend
