Peer Support / One-On-One

Peer Mentoring:

- Identifying obtainable short term goals in preparation for long-term success
- Persevering towards achievement
- Building goals for independent living skills

Post Secondary Counseling:

- Aiding students in building post secondary portfolios
- Teaching students to self-identify academic and functional needs / strengths
- Explore interests and preferences
- Discuss post secondary options





In School Work-based Learning Program

- The AbilityThrift onsite program provides students with disabilities opportunity to experience and learn transferrable skills for high demand job markets
- Built around the second hand marketplace, We utilize donations provided by the school and community to process and place for sale on a digital marketplace.
- This program serves 10-15 participants per session and is scheduled based on the school needs.



INDEPENDENT LIVING & PEER MENTORING SERVICES

- Peer Mentoring Service Professionals with disabilities working with people with disabilities to promote independence through life skills training, goal setting and mentorship.
- ► This is one of the 5 core services AccessAbility Provides. Goal oriented planning is the central strategy for successful mentoring.
- ► Transitioning Students can benefit from this free, ongoing service in and after high school as a continued support outside of other partnering services in the community. This service is essential when a student is lacking services due to unforeseen circumstances or qualifying factors. Goal setting to engage and attain services is strategic part of our planning if they are desired by the student.
- One on One 45 min meetings are setup up by the student in a weekly, biweekly or monthly ongoing orientation depending on his or her goals.

INDEPENDENT LIVING & PEER MENTORING SERVICES

Many students do not have an opportunity to receive services once they have finished school. Accessibility is able to provide Peer Mentoring and Independent Living Services before, during and after transition.

A few examples of skills we can work on:

- -Budgeting and Financial Literacy
- -Learners Permit/License Training and Car Maintenance
- Interview Prep, resume writing and assistance with applications

Through Peer Mentoring we can help the students learn to advocate for themselves as well as empowering themselves and others.
