



2017-2018 was a fantastic year for Verbum Dei. Ninety-five percent of the Class of 2018 was accepted to a four-year college or university. Verbum Dei had a record number of competitive freshmen applications and met our goal of 110 freshmen. The faculty and staff of Verbum Dei High School are blessed to serve these amazing young men as they transition from boyhood to manhood, students to lifelong learners, citizens to agents of change for their communities and the world.

The Mission Advancement department had a particularly successful year as well. We broke records with our Adopt-A-Student Program, receiving sponsorship for 45% of our student body. Our Annual Spring Gala raised an unprecedented \$470,000, which directly funded much needed student scholarships.




