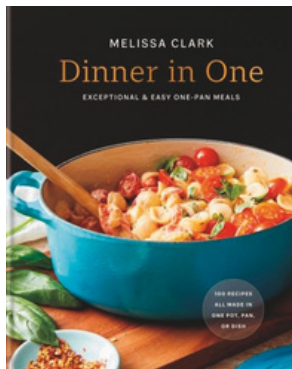


CHINA TRAVELS, PART 1: HANGZHOU, WENZHOU AND SHANGHAI
