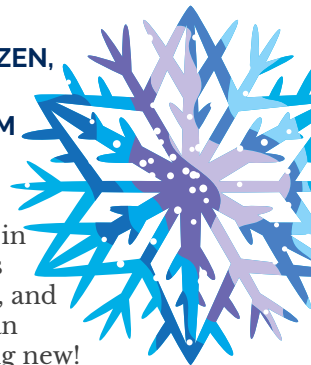
#### S.M.ART KIDS: DISNEY STEM: FROZEN, GRADES 1ST-5TH
