### Living our Mission

St. Dominic's 50-acre campus is among the largest of any Catholic high school in the St. Louis area, featuring a wide range of indoor and outdoor spaces for students to learn, pray and grow. Located on Interstate 70 in O'Fallon and serving families living in St. Charles, Lincoln and Warren counties. This closeness to home makes it possible for students and their families to be active members of the school community, making St. Dominic not just a school, but a second home. At our core, St. Dominic strives to form disciples of Jesus Christ. We live out our mission by modeling the four Dominican pillars of Prayer, Study, Community and Service. These pillars are visible on our walls and present in the minds and hearts of our students. These four pillars are both the foundation of and the avenues by which we achieve our mission of forming disciples of Jesus Christ. Ultimately, the goal of discipleship is carried out when students can witness the faith to their peers by evangelizing on their teams and in their classrooms; it can be seen in the students who actively participate in our mission.

### Prayer

Our Catholic faith is at the core of our identity at St. Dominic High School. In addition to our four-year religion curriculum and seven faith-based student organizations, the student body regularly participates in Masses, Eucharistic Adoration, Reconciliation services and retreats.

### Study

As a comprehensive, college preparatory Catholic high school, St. Dominic fosters the growth and long-term success of every student, regardless of academic ability. Our engaged, caring faculty is personally invested in each student's academic achievement. Our college preparatory curriculum and block schedule format allow classes to dive deep into content each session and help prepare students for college studies.
