Online Paperwork

Once again, we are using a parent online form submission process. You should have received a letter and login username and I.D. when you received your class placement letter. If you visit the district website at smfschools.org, simply click on the "Annual Forms & Consent Portal" icon and it will take you right to the sign-in page. Please complete this process ASAP so that we have updated emergency information about your child.

Please let the office know if you did not receive login information or if you are having problems.

If you do not have internet access, there are computers in the office that you are welcome to use to complete your forms.



Please leave your dogs/pets at home when coming on to school property. We have students who have anxiety about dogs and we have also had a student who was recently bitten by a dog.

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS:

Please be specific when signing out your child in the office. Due to new attendance regulations at the state level, signing out for an "appointment" is no longer acceptable. We need to know what type of appointment you will be going to. (For example, "doctor" or "dentist")

Any time missed for vacation or travel time must be noted on the Planned Absence form, even when leaving school early for travel. Up to five (5) days of planned vacation is considered excused. Anything beyond five days may be considered unexcused.

Remember to contact the office at 330-689-5330 no later than 9:30am to report your child absent for the day.

Mail

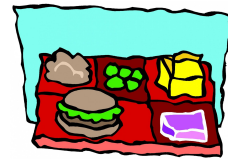
Thank you for your continued support of this project. Not only does it help recycle our paper waste but it also is a source of funding for our building.
