IDEA-B Federal Grant

Allocations are from the federal government which flow through the Ohio Department of Education to local school districts.

ODE determines the amount of money a school district receives by:

1. The 1998 December Child Count;
2. Current count of public and private average daily membership; and
3. Current count of students living in poverty

Grant amounts are decreased as the percent of students living in poverty also decreases because ODE believes that districts with lower poverty levels have increased local dollars to pay for services.

Use of Funds

Funds may be only be used for special education programming and resources for students with disabilities.

Funds are also directed towards nonpublic schools who provide services for students with disabilities.

Total Allocation: \$1,070,555.96

- Decrease of \$126,463.33 from the adjusted allocation last year.

Nonpublic (Holy Family) receives \$18,672.48.
