2023 FORMAT AND SCHEDULE

ESOL graduate level courses will meet in-person in Goshen at OU BOCES or in a hybrid in-person/online format, with some meetings in person and some synchronous online. There will be two ESOL classes offered in the spring and two in the summer, so that participants can be complete before September 2023. Bilingual Education graduate level courses will meet synchronously online.

ESOL Certification Series

- EDU 5204 Methods of TESOL, meeting Thursdays 4:00-6:30 from January 19 to May 4, in person
- EDU 5202 Introduction to Linguistics, meeting Tuesdays 4:00-6:30 from January 17 to May 2, alternating in-person and online

Bilingual Certification Series

- EDU 5554 Methods of Teaching in Bilingual Education, meeting synchronously online on Wednesdays from 4:20 to 6:50 from January 18 to May 3

TUITION

Tuition will be \$487.50 per credit, which is a 50% discount. There are registration, CTLE, and technology fees of \$455. Therefore, each course costs a total of \$1917.50. Part of the payment goes to Manhattanville and part of the payment goes to OU BOCES.
