


WEST VIEW DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION: A COMMUNITY WITHIN A COMMUNITY

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WHAT IS A DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION PROGRAM?

In West View's Dual Language Immersion program, students learn in two languages: both English and Spanish. From kindergarten to third grade, students are taught 80% in Spanish and 20% in English, allowing them to develop literacy and speaking abilities in both languages. Instruction then



transitions to 50% Spanish and 50% English in fourth grade. The model of our program enables students to develop proficiency in both languages, strengthen academic learning and achievement, and cultivate an understanding and appreciation of different cultures.


