SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The honors program at CBHS gathers a community of the most gifted and dedicated students to hold each other to the highest standards of academic achievement and leadership. The De La Salle Scholars are a group of boys bound together with common goals of serving the community and supporting one another in achieving extraordinary academic accomplishments. Members of this program will have the opportunity to take a wide range of AP and collegiate dual-enrollment classes throughout their four years.

DE LA SALLE SCHOLAR EVENTS & BENEFITS

In addition to their rigorous academic schedule, De La Salle Scholars are involved in many events and other opportunities on campus and in the community, including the following:

- Career Day Host - Scholars receive priority registration and have the opportunity to network with alumni at a special breakfast.
- College Road Tour - Scholars have priority registration for the week long college road tour visiting up to ten universities. Rising sophomore scholars are the only sophomores invited to participate.
- Job Shadowing - Alumni host junior and senior scholars at their job sites giving them first hand experience with potential career choices.
- Executive Lunches - Through these small group lunches with alumni, students discover more about careers and educational pathways. Scholars have priority registration.
- Peer Academic Mentoring - Scholars are expected to serve their community with their academic gifts by being academic peer mentors, volunteering at our tutoring labs, or tutoring elementary students.
- PSAT Prep - PSAT practice sessions are provided for scholars.

BECOMING A DE LA SALLE SCHOLAR

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- Total of 12 honors/AP credits from sophomore to senior year (AP courses count as 1.5 credits)
- Cumulative 4.0 GPA maintained through the end of 7th semester
- Fulfill required service hours
- Participated in De La Salle Scholar community service activities and peer tutoring programs
- Demonstrated leadership experience
- Attend De La Salle Scholars meetings and events
