What is the point of Google Meets?

Teacher reviews previous concepts.

Teacher talks about current work through demonstrations, examples, and/or answering student questions.

Teacher works with students to clarify expectations.

Students work on the class work during the google meet so they can ask questions if they get stuck.

Students leave each Google Meet with:

A clear understanding of what work is due when.

A clearer understanding of content and skills.
