Rules and Agreement

The Lee County High School Robert A. Clay Auditorium is a state of the art performing arts center for Lee County High School and the community. The auditorium was recently updated with a new lighting and sound system and we are thrilled! There are a few rules and procedures we ask that you abide by while renting/using the facility. We ask that you PLEASE stress to your audience that there will be *NO* food or drink in the auditorium at any time. We have custodians that sweep and vacuum but we will *NOT* allow any food or beverage while in the auditorium. The dance studio may have food or drinks closely monitored.

- The person in charge of your organization/program will need to make sure these areas are clean and trash is thrown away after the event. If equipment is brought in it must be removed *immediately* after the event. We have multiple organizations and groups that use the facility.
 - **Boys and girls dressing rooms. (If used)**
 - **Dance studio (if used)**
 - **Trash and programs picked up off the floor in the auditorium.**
 - **If tape is used on the stage, please remove promptly after the event.**
