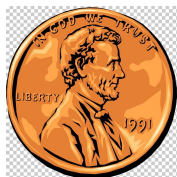

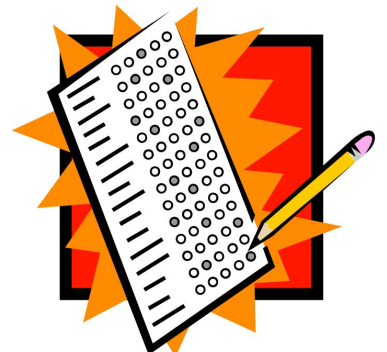
Also, thank you to families for following directions and helping to make the whole program run smoothly.
