

Dress Code Guidelines Newman Catholic Schools – Early Childhood Programs

Students' dress and personal appearance are primarily the responsibility of each individual student and parent. However, Newman Catholic Schools, as part of the Diocese of La Crosse, is required to follow a more defined dress code for the schools of the school program. As part of Newman Catholic Schools, the early childhood centers are also bound to follow certain standards of dress for both students and staff.

Basic standards for children enrolled at the early childhood centers are:

- Age appropriate clothing
- Clothing that is comfortable, appropriately sized and is appropriate to the activities
 of children and the season
- Style and manner of dress promotes a positive learning environment
- Style and manner of dress helps students grow in the virtue of modesty and promotes self-respect
