

<p>SC 1850.1, Title 22 Sec. 4.31</p>	<p>Written criteria for evaluating the admission of eligible students shall be developed in cooperation with the participating school districts and distributed.</p>
<p>Title 22 Sec. 4.31</p>	<p>Course announcements, tours, presentations, guidance materials, and other communications shall convey the philosophy of equal access to career and technical programs and shall include admissions criteria and procedures.</p>
<p>Title 22 Sec. 4.4</p>	<p>The A. W. Beattie Career Center shall not discriminate in any way on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, marital status, disability, age or limited English proficiency in its programs or activities with regard to the admissions of students.</p> <p>Names of applicants that cannot be enrolled because of class size shall be placed on a waiting list to be considered when openings exist.</p>
	<p><u>Admission of Qualified Students with Disabilities</u></p> <p>Each student with a disability as defined in either Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act or the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) on the list, shall have a completed Section 504 Plan or IEP developed by the home district that must include input from the Career Center.</p> <p>The student's Section 504/IEP Team shall reach a determination that the Career Center provides an appropriate program for the student prior to the student's admission into the program.</p>
<p>Title 22 Sec. 339.21</p>	<p>With regard to the placement of students with IEP's or Section 504 Plans in vocational programming, faculty from the vocational programs in which students are recommended for placement will participate as members of the IEP or Section 504 Team. IEP and Section 504 Team meetings, when scheduled by the school district, must give timely notice to the Career Center representative assigned and shall be attended by the Career Center education representative.</p>
