PREGANT/MARRIED STUDENTS</p> <p>A student who is eligible to attend the Career Center and is married and/or pregnant shall not be denied an educational program solely because of marriage, pregnancy, pregnancy-related disabilities, or potential or actual parenthood.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee reserves the right to require as a prerequisite for attendance in the regular classes of the Career Center and the extracurricular program of the Career Center that each pregnant student present to the Executive Director or designee a licensed physician's written statement that such activity will not be injurious to her health nor jeopardize her pregnancy.</p> <p>A student who is married must declare his/her marital status at the time of the marriage or at the time of enrollment in the Career Center.</p> <p>A pregnant student whose mental or physical condition prevents her from attending regular classes, when such condition is certified by a licensed physician, may be reassigned to an alternate educational program by the sending district.</p> <p>A student who has received an alternate educational program for reasons associated with her pregnancy shall be readmitted to the regular Career Center program upon her request and written statement of a licensed physician that she is physically fit to do so.</p> <p>The Executive Director shall develop procedures for implementing this policy which may include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Offering counseling services to help students plan their future.</li> <li>2. Cooperation with community resources to assist students.</li> <li>3.
