	307. STUDENT TEACHERS
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee (JOC) encourages cooperation with colleges and universities within the state in the training of student teachers. Therefore, the Career Center and Kiddie Tech will accept student teachers from accredited institutions of higher learning approved by the JOC legally-certified services.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	Under the direction of the Executive Director and in coordination with the Career Center principal, student teachers from accredited colleges and universities may be assigned for student teaching experience in the Career Center, including Kiddie Tech.
SC 1418 Title 28 Sec. 23,.43, 23.44, 23.45 Pol. 414	Student teachers shall comply with the health examination of the state and the policy of this district as it applies to certificated personnel.
	Student teachers while serving in the Career Center and Kiddie Tech shall be responsible for their conduct to the supervising teacher and building principal.
	Student teachers assigned in the Career Center and Kiddie Tech shall be subject to the policies, practices, and procedures of the Career Center and Kiddie Tech.
SC111	Student teachers shall report, on the designated form, arrests and convictions as required by law. In addition, Career Center and Kiddie Tech student teachers are required to report to the Career Center within seventy-two (72) hours any arrest or conviction of an offense listed in Section 111(e) or (f.1) that occurs after September 28, 2011. Failure to accurately report such arrests and convictions may, depending on the nature of the offense, subject the individual to criminal prosecution and/or termination of employment.
	The Executive Director shall ensure the distribution of student teachers throughout the Career Center so that no single groups of pupils or teachers will be subject to excessive student teacher classroom hours.

Student teachers or faculty of other educational institutions shall be offered the opportunity to visit and observe in the Career Center. Such observers must be treated as any other visitor and shall be under the direct supervision of the principal.
