Beattie Career Center Joint Operating Committee (JOC) recognizes the importance of the public's right to have access to public records of the Career Center, including public financial records. The public has the right under law to inspect and procure copies of the annual audit conducted by the Career Center's accountants and the audit conducted by the Auditor General's office.
 Authority SC 437, 2401 2408, 2441 	The Joint Operating Committee shall employ an independent, certified public accountant to conduct an annual Career Center audit in conformance with prescribed and legal standards. The completed audit shall be presented to the Joint Operating Committee for its examination and acceptance.
	The Joint Operating Committee recognizes its obligation as an elected body to represent the best interests of all its constituents. Therefore, the Joint Operating Committee shall make the results of both the Career Center's accountant's audit and the Auditor General's audit available to the public at the business office of the Career Center and on the Career Center's website.
 Delegation of Responsibility SC 218 	The Executive Director and Board Recording Secretary shall annually, by December 31, submit a signed statement to the Pennsylvania Department of Education certifying that the financial statements of the Career Center have been properly audited pursuant to law and that in the independent auditor's opinion, the financial information submitted in the annual financial report is materially consistent with the audited financial statements. If the financial information is not deemed materially consistent the Career Center shall submit a revised annual financial report no later than December 31.
